Wednesday Jan 8th 1851
this day moderate wind from the East heading S.W. at 5 P.M. the Island
of Mangrove being 12 miles off port the Island of Enos
lat 16° 22' 22" long 151° 18'

Remarks Thursday Jan 9th 1851
this day moderate wind and pleasant at 4 P.M. sent the boat on shore to
trade at Enos returned at 9 P.M. the boat went on shore again to
trade at Enos the boat is now at Enos

Remarks Friday Jan 10th 1851
this day moderate wind and pleasant weather the boat on shore
trading this day the Captain filled the Rev. Mr. Gill and
family to Enos to Mangrove the natives to Mangrove having
some trouble at Enos bought 2 pigs 12 head of cattle some fruit etc.

Remarks Saturday Jan 11th 1851
this day light wind from the East at 2 P.M. the Rev. Mr. Gill and family
came on board at 3 P.M. the ship for Enos at 5 P.M.
saw the Island being 12 miles off port 40 miles to Enos steering
for the Island

Remarks Sunday Jan 12th 1851
this day moderate wind and pleasant at 4 P.M. left the land
and at 5 P.M. had the place at 9 P.M. the Rev. Mr. Gill and family
came on board at 2 P.M. sent 40 lbs of each for water to Enos

Remarks Monday Jan 13th 1851
this day strong wind and squally from East at 3 P.M. came
up with the water and kept the ship to the southward to Enos
with all sail employed in ship only lat 16° 22' 10" long 151° 18'

Remarks Tuesday Jan 14th 1851
there is strong wind from the East heading South
with all sail set employed in ship only lat 16° 24' 19" long 151° 18'

Remarks Wednesday Jan 15th 1851
this day moderate wind from East heading South with all
sail employed in ship only lat 16° 25' 42" long 151° 18'

Remarks Thursday Jan 16th 1851
at this day moderate wind from East heading South employed
in mending boats repairing sails etc. lat 16° 27' 40" long 151° 18'

Remarks Friday Jan 17th 1851
this day moderate wind from the East heading South employed
in repairing sails to Enos with all sail set lat 16° 29' 25" long 151° 18'

Remarks Saturday Jan 18th 1851
this day moderate wind and pleasant weather from the E.S.E.
heading South with all sail set employed in mending
the foremast to Enos lat 16° 31' 22" long 151° 18'

Remarks On Board Ship Mechanic of New Port Rhode Island
Sunday Jan 19th 1851
this day commenced with moderate wind from the E.S.E. heading South with
all sail set at 10 P.M. sent the boat to Enos
lat 16° 32' 22" long 151° 18'

Remarks Monday Jan 20th 1851
this day moderate wind from the E.S.E. heading South
at 4 P.M. commenced mending ship to Enos lat 16° 34' 22" long 151° 18'

Remarks Tuesday Jan 21th 1851
first part this day moderate wind at Enos lat 16° 35' 22" long 151° 18'

Remarks Wednesday Jan 22th 1851
this day calm and squally improving sails and mending foremast
at Enos lat 16° 35' 44" long 151° 18'

Remarks Thursday Jan 23th 1851
first part this day light air from South heading E.S.E. middle part
moderate wind from S.E. heading E.S.E. latter part the same
employed in repairing the foremast to Enos with all sail set
lat 16° 35' 44" long 151° 18'

Remarks Friday Jan 24th 1851
this day moderate wind from S.E. heading East with all sail set
employed in repairing the foremast to Enos
lat 16° 35' 44" long 151° 18'

Remarks Saturday Jan 25th 1851
this day this day moderate wind from S.E. heading East
middle part strong wind latter part strong wind and squally
to Enos employed mending sails lat 16° 36' 22" long 151° 18'

Remarks Sunday Jan 26th 1851
first part this day strong wind from South heading E.S.E. middle part
fresh gale from the South latter part fresh gale and squally
lat 16° 35' 44" long 151° 18'

Remarks Monday Jan 27th 1851
first part fresh gale and squally middle part from moderate
latter part calm to Enos employed in ship only
lat 16° 37' 10" long 151° 18'

Remarks Tuesday Jan 28th 1851
first part this day calm middle part light breeze
from West steering E.S.E. latter part fresh wind
from S.W. steering E.S.E. to Enos one sail on light
employed in ship only lat 16° 37' 57" long 151° 18'

Remarks Wednesday Jan 29th 1851
this day fresh gale from West steering East 4 P.M. mending foremast and mending foremast
to Enos lat 16° 38' 19" long 151° 18'
