Liberty David Breunard Edwin Shurles and
Joseph Bucklin Deserted from the Brig all
Attempts to arrest them were useless at present

Monday May the 3rd
These 24 hours fine weather employed in painting
ship and taking of wood and water and watch
on shore Charles Smith Deserted while on
Liberty this is the third time he has Deserted
from us but he all way has apprehended
and brought back but all attempts to
Apprehend him this time was useless
