

Remarks on board Monday May the 22nd 1848 these 24 hours
begins with light breeze from E. & all the first Part
of these 24 hours we had light wind the latter Part
fine breeze from N. by E. the Brig heading S. by E.
So Encls this day all hands employed in ship's
duty Lat 35° 56' N Long 50° West

Remarks on board Tuesday May the 23rd 1848 these 24
hours begins with strong wind from N. by N.
the Brig heading S. by E. & we saw a school of
Blackfish we saw our boats But could not
get fast of them. we have on board 1 Angel heaved
forward steering S. & the middle and latter Part
the same the Brig heading S. by E. with all sail
set So Encls this day Lat Long

Remarks on board Wednesday May the 24th 1848 this
day begins with fine breeze from N. by N. the Brig
heading S. by E. with all Parrellel sail set
the middle and latter Part of these 24 hours light
wind from the N. the Brig heading S. by E. with all sail
for the island So Encls this day the crew employed
in ship's duty Lat 36° 15' N Long 45° W

Remarks on board Thursday May the 25th 1848 these 24 hours
begins with light wind from N. by N. the Brig heading S. by E.
4 P.M. we saw for Blackfish But came on board
without success the first Part of these 24 hours
light breeze from N. by N. the Brig heading S. by E. the
latter Part calm saw a Brig of war hauled
quarter dist 5 miles So Encls this day the crew
employed in ship's duty Lat 36° N Long 45° W

Remarks on board Friday May the 26th 1848 these 24
hours begins with light wind from N. by N. the Brig
heading S. by E. So Encls these 24 hours with light wind
the Brig heading S. by E. with all Parrellel sail set
for the western islands So Encls these 24 hours the
crew employed in ship's duty Lat 36° 23' N Long

Remarks on board Saturday May the 27th 1848 this day
begins with light breeze from N. by N. 2 P.M. saw
school of porpoises 4 P.M. we saw school of Blackfish we
saw a small boat came on 5 P.M. took him a long sail
and sent him on 7 P.M. we took him sail heading
S. by E. we were ship heading N. by E. So Encls this day
with fine breeze and clear Lat Long 43° 17' N

Remarks on board Sunday May the 28th 1848 these 24 hours
begins with light wind from N. by N. 1 P.M. we made
the Port of Hatteras but in Maston 26 hours
out from 3 P.M. we saw Humpbacks near the Brig 7 P.M.
we took in sail heading S. by E. the latter Part of this day strong breeze the Brig heading
N. by N.

Remarks on board Monday May the 29th 1848 these
24 hours begins with strong wind from N. by N. the Brig heading S. by E. under short sail the
latter Part of these 24 hours blowing hard from S. by E. the
Watch employed Bailing out Blackfish So Encls this
day Lat 36° 42' N Long 40° W

Remarks on board Tuesday May the 30th 1848 these 24
hours begins with strong wind from S. by E. the Brig
heading S. by E. under short sail the latter Part of these 24 hours
blowing hard from S. by E. the Watch employed Bailing out Blackfish So Encls this
day Lat 37° 21' N Long 40° 00' W

Remarks on board Wednesday May the 31st 1848 these 24 hours
begins with strong wind from S. by E. the Brig heading S. by E.
the latter Part light breeze from S. by E. the latter Part
with squalls of rain So Encls these 24 hours with light
wind Lat 38° 14' N Long 40° 00' W

Remarks on board June the 1st 1848 these 24 hours begins
with light wind from the latter Part of these 24 hours light
wind from the South attended with squalls of rain the Brig heading
S. by E. under short sail saw porpoises So Encls this day
Lat 39° 00' N Long 41° 10' W

Remarks on board Friday June the 2nd 1848 these 24 hours begins
with strong wind from S. by E. the Brig heading S. by E. the
latter Part of these 24 hours strong wind the latter Part the same So Encls
this day the Brig heading S. by E. Lat Long

Remarks on board Saturday June the 3rd 1848 these 24 hours begins
with strong breeze from the South the Brig heading S. by E.
under short sail all the first Part of these 24 hours we
had strong breeze from the South attended with squalls of
rain 2 P.M. we had the wind from N. by N. attended with
hard rain 4 P.M. fine breeze from S. by E. the Brig heading
S. by E. for the western islands with all Parrellel sail
set So Encls this day Lat 39° 54' N Long 37° 00' W

Remarks on board Sunday June the 4th 1848 this day begins
with strong wind from N. by N. the Brig heading S. by E. with
all sail set all the first Part of these 24 hours fine wind
from N. by N. the latter Part the same the Brig heading
S. by E. with square yards with all sail set for the western
islands So Encls these 24 hours Lat Long
