Remarks on board Wednesday July the 19th these 24 hours
begin with light wind from the E the Brig heading N. by E
4 PM took in sail left to the wind heading N. by E
4 PM we made sail steering S. by W. with the first
part of these 24 hours we had light wind and fair weather
so ends this day Lat 38° 27' N Long 32° 09' W

Remarks on board Thursday July the 20th these 24 hours
begin with light wind from the E the Brig heading N. by E
for the western ground 7 PM shortened sail 4 AM made
sail heading S. by W. by the wind so ends this day Lat 32° 38' N
Long 37° 28' W

1848
Remarks on board Friday July the 21st these 24 hours
begin with fine breeze from the W 7 PM we shortened
sail 4 AM made sail 11 AM ship steering N. W. the latter
part of these 24 hours we had strong wind from N. W. so ends
this day Lat 37° 00' N Long 32° 56' W

1848
Remarks on board Saturday July the 22nd this day begin with
strong wind from N. W. the Brig heading S. by W. 7 PM we shortened
sail heading W. 4 AM we made sail steering W. by S. sail
4 AM so ends this day with light breeze from N. W. so
Lat 36° 48' N Long 33° 20' W

1848
Remarks on board Sunday July the 23rd this day begins
with light wind 4 PM of ship passed over stern E. N. E
5 PM we had some rain 7 PM took in sail heading
N. by W. 4 AM made sail steering W. for the western
ground the latter part of these 24 hours we had strong
breeze from the S so ends this day Lat 36° 37' N Long
36° 37' W

Remarks on board Monday July the 24th this day
begin with strong wind from the S the Brig heading
W. 7 PM we took in sail 8 AM ship steering E. by S
4 AM we made sail steering N. by the wind so ends this day
with strong wind Lat 36° 50' N Long 37° 30' W

1848
Remarks on board Tuesday July the 25th these 24 hours
begin with fine breeze from S. by W. the Brig heading
N. by W. 7 PM took in sail 4 AM we made sail steering
S. W. saw a school of porpoise so ends this day Lat 36° 18'
Long 37° 40' W

1848
Remarks on board Wednesday July the 26th this day
begin with strong wind from N. W. the Brig heading S. by W.
16 PM we shortened sail heading N. by W. 4 AM we made
sail heading S. by W. so ends this day with strong wind from
the W Lat 35° 39' N Long 36° 00' W

1848
Remarks on board Thursday July the 27th these 24 hours
begin with fine breeze from N. W. the Brig heading S. by W.
the latter part of this day we had the wind from the N. the
Brig heading N. by S. for the western ground so ends
these 24 hours with light breeze Lat 34° 37' N
Long 36° 04' W

1848
Remarks on board Friday July the 28th these 24 hours
begin with light wind from the N the Brig heading N. by E
7 PM shortened sail 4 AM made sail steering N. by E
so ends these 24 hours with light wind from the
N Lat 34° 11' N Long 37° 01' W

1848
Remarks on board Saturday July the 29th these 24 hours
begin with light wind from N. by E the Brig heading N. for
the western ground all the first part of these 24 hours we had
light wind from the N 10 AM we saw a school of Blackfish
we heard but we have on board without success so ends this
day with light wind from the E Lat 33° 30' N Long 37° 57' W

1848
Remarks on board Sunday July the 30th these 24 hours
begin with light wind from the E the Brig heading N. by W. the
squad yards 7 PM took in sail all the first part of these 24
we had light wind from the E the latter part we had strong wind
from the E so ends this day Lat 32° 48' N Long 38° 55' W

1848
Remarks on board Monday July the 31st these 24 hours begin
with strong breeze from the E the Brig heading W. for the western
ground 7 PM we took in sail left to the wind heading South
4 AM appeared in the yards steering N. by W. saw white water
but could not get 43 stairs what it was so ends this day with
fine wind from the E Lat 33° 04' N Long 40° 18' W

1848
Remarks on board August the 1st these 24 hours begin
with fine wind from the E the Brig heading N. by W. 4 PM
we saw two sail steering N. E 7 PM we shortened sail left
to the wind heading S. by E 4 AM made sail steering N. by W.
8 AM we saw a school of sperm whales 4 miles from the
Brig we heard our boats and let up with them the Blackfish
and porpoises let with them and the whales was killed
and then went to the windward quick we chased them
but could not get up with them so ends this day
Lat 33° 20' N Long 40° 35' W

1848
Remarks on board Wednesday Aug the 2nd these 24 hours begin
with light wind from the E the Boats in chase of whales
5 PM we on board took in sail heading S. by E the middle
part of these 24 hours began the latter part light wind
steamed with rain thunder and lightning one of the
men was struck with it so ends this day

1848
Remarks on board Thursday Aug the 3rd these 24 hours
begin with strong breeze from the S the Brig heading
N. by E 2 PM we passed a black Brig 7 PM took in sail
heading N. by W. 4 AM made sail steering N. by W. 10 AM saw
a school of sperm 4 miles from the Brig we found our
boats and let up with them 12 AM we struck three of
them they were sent so ends this day with light
wind Lat 33° 55' N Long 41° 52' W
