heading N N E the middle and latter part the same
so ends these 24 hours with strong breeze Lat Long

Remarks on board Monday Aug the 21 these 24 hours
begins with strong breeze from S & E 1 P.M. we spoke the
Schooner Lucia of Provincetown - young Master 5 months
out 165 Barrels of Spinn oil 8 P.M. we were ship heading
S & E 4 A.M. we made sail 5 A.M. squally we took in sail
7 A.M. made sail steering E & S by the wind we saw 2 men
I heard so ends this day with strong wind from the South
Lat 34-58 N Long 44-30 W

Remarks on board Tuesday Aug the 22 these 24 hours
begins with strong wind from the South the Brig heading
E & S under short sail 4 A.M. we made sail steering
N & W 10 A.M. we saw a Bear to the Seward we saw 4 men
and spoke it was the Bark regatta of Shumath black
clad 20 months out with 580 barrels of Spinn oil
so ends this day Lat 35-13 N Long 44-25 W

Remarks on board Wednesday Aug the 23 these 24 hours
begins with light wind from the S 1 P.M. we saw 11 white
water a head but could not distinguish what it was
9 P.M. we were ship heading N N W by the wind all the
first and middle part of this day light breeze from S N
the latter part strong wind from S N the Brig heading
E N E with squall yards so ends Lat Long

Remarks on board Thursday Aug the 24 these 24
hours begins with strong wind from N N E 2 P.M.
we saw a breach of our weather we stood towards
it but could not distinguish what it was 4 A.M.
we made sail 5 A.M. we saw a Schooner a head
9 A.M. we squared in the yards steering S S W
11 A.M. we were ship heading E N E so ends this day with
strong wind from S N Lat 35-45 N Long 43-45 W

Remarks on board Friday Aug the 25th this day begins
with light wind from S N the Brig heading E 4 A.M.
we were ship heading N N W 10 A.M. we were ship heading
S S W the first and middle part of these 24 hours we had
light wind the latter part strong wind from N so ends
this day Lat 35-47 N Long 43-49 W

Remarks on board Saturday Aug the 26th these 24 hours
begins with strong wind from the N the Brig heading S
9 P.M. we saw a School of Blackfish we saw 2 men
heads but could not distinguish what it was 5 P.M. we were ship heading
S S W a head the latter part of this day we had squally
weather wind N the Brig heading N so ends this day

Remarks on board Sunday Aug the 27th these 24 hours begins with
squally weather wind N 1 P.M. we were ship heading S S W the middle
part of this day we had light wind from the N the Brig heading
S S W under short sail 11 A.M. we were ship heading N E so ends
this day with light wind Lat 34-58 N Long 43-40 W

Remarks on board Monday Aug the 28th these 24 hours begins
with light wind from N N W the Brig heading N N E we saw
squall yards all the first part of these 24 hours we had light
wind from the N the Brig heading to the Westward the latter
part we had squally weather the Brig heading N E with
squall yards so ends this day the wind employed in
rolling up the Dyeing Lat 35-00 N Long 43-04 W

Remarks on board Tuesday Aug the 29th these 24 hours
begins with light wind from the N the Brig heading N E
we saw a sail a head the middle and latter part of this day
we had strong breeze from N N W attended with squalls
of rain so ends this day Lat 35-20 N Long 42-35 W

Remarks on board Wednesday Aug the 30th these 24 hours
begins with strong wind from N N E 1 P.M. we saw 10 sails of
our starboard now the Brig heading to the Eastward
1 P.M. we took in sail 4 A.M. we were ship heading to the Westward
8 A.M. we saw a whaler so ends this day with light wind
Lat Long

Remarks on board Thursday Aug the 31 these 24 hours
begins with strong breeze from N N E the Brig heading N
the wind 2 P.M. we had a heavy squall we took in all sail
except the Spruce we were ship heading N N W by the wind
9 P.M. we took in the top sail all the first and latter part of
this day we had squally weather the latter part the Brig
heading N N E under short sail sail of ship steering
E so ends this day Lat Long

Remarks on board Friday Sept the 1 these 24 hours
begins with strong wind from N N E the Brig heading
N N E under short sail all the first and middle part
of these 24 hours we had squally weather the latter part
fine breeze from the N 10 A.M. we squared in the yards
steering N saw whales so ends this day Lat 36-30 N
Long 43-05 W

1848
Remarks on board Saturday Sept the 2 these 24 hours
begins with light breeze from N N E the Brig heading N E
9 P.M. we were ship heading N N E the wind heading N took in the
top sail all the first part of this day we had light wind
from the N the middle and latter part strong breeze
the Brig heading E under short sail so ends this
day with strong wind Lat 36-58 N Long 41-35 W
