

Cruising in Narra Passage Contd
March Saturday the 18th sea acct. 1849
Fresh gales & squally, rather variable for
the Boat for Blackfish but it none to say
set up the topmast & lower rigging & painter
so ends this day v.c. well

March Sunday the 19th sea acct 1849
Fresh gales the whole day & squally with
variability. At 4 P.M. found for Blackfish but got
none. Launches can be seen in sailing up rigging
so ends the day & v.c. well v.c.

March Monday the 20th sea acct 1849
Pleasant gales from South East ship beating
up the Roca River Coast. at 4 P.M. went on shore
& bought some plantains, Coco nut, & oranges
for fresh at 6 o'clock left ship & went out to sea at 6
at 10 o'clock the ship off at 11 o'clock passed by Monte
at 12 Noon so ends the day

March Tuesday the 21st sea acct 1849
First part this day light breeze from the
N.E. last part fresh from South East at 8 P.M. found
the off the East End of St. Domingo headed South of 6 o'clock
at 12 noon the island of St. Domingo of Laona is
seen as a mountain of Hurry of Back so ends the day a new
Schoon & went down the hill one so good v.c. good, v.c.

March Wednesday the 22nd sea acct 1849
Fresh gales from North East & pleasant at
10 o'clock from boat & went down the island of St.
at 11 o'clock when we set about going to the ship for
Boats, at 12 o'clock found some, on the island so ends
the day at 12 o'clock of the City of St. Domingo.

March Thursday the 23rd sea acct 1849
Fresh gales from N.E. at 7 P.M. part before
Boat at 10 o'clock & went into San Juan, at 11
at 12 o'clock of the Chalk Cliffs at 1 o'clock spoke the ship
Charles A. Thompson, from New York to the mouth of the
& gained with the ship, found to day saw the Schoon Council
Gamer so ends the day v.c. all well

March Friday the 24th sea acct 1849
First part this day pleasant & many of the last
part rough & windy, saw the Barque "Washington" (Cham)
then left to Big Mexico, do. Micoconcha see sperm from
out, Mexico 15, sperm 15, 2nd, so ends the day v.c.

Cruising in San Juan
March Saturday the 25th sea acct 1849
First part this day fresh gales last part
moderate & slightly at 1 P.M. home to anchor
in San Juan & went down main to market
& got the cages & rest & rigging & set it up again
all hands painting ship & getting rigging &
pumpkin stuff to lighten her & repairing
leeches, v.c. so ends the day

March Sunday the 26th sea acct 1849
Pleasant gales from all points of the compass &
light, the ship painting & anchor in San Juan, a
painting & getting rigging & so ends the day all well

March Monday the 27th sea acct 1849
Light & pleasant weather, ship lying in San
Juan to day mended the Stern Board & had her over
boarded to, some water, had a very heavy piece of iron at 6 P.
at which took 2 hours and a half, went on shore at 6
at 10 o'clock a fly by the ship, so ends the day v.c. all well.

March Tuesday the 28th sea acct 1849
Very light gales from Southward & very smooth
at 10 o'clock went to weigh from San Juan & ran down
to the watering place & filled 60 Barrels fresh water
so ends the day v.c. v.c. all well

March Wednesday the 29th sea acct 1849
Light breezes from S.E. & South, ship lying at
the watering place, taking in wood & water, went on
shore my aboard Boat & got some logs & found
so ends the day v.c.

March Thursday the 30th sea acct 1849
Light breezes from the South & at 1 P.M. went
to shore & had ground Board & called rowing & lost
the anchor from San Juan & the Derivation, saw some
6 hours after the liberty had expired at 8 P.M.
returned getting most checked to Boat, then
got under weigh & stood out to the ground
at 11 o'clock sail & kept the ship at 12
Liberty at 12 o'clock of Chalk Cliffs v.c. v.c.

March Friday the 31st sea acct 1849
Fresh Trade, all day it being quite rough
continued until morning steady the Coast
all dark when we took our sail & hummer
