

Remarks on Board Brig Medford.

August the 25th sea a cct. 1849

Fine weather & light winds from S W. Today saw 2 sail, bound E. Libearse saw some Frenchmen, at 2 P.M. kept the ship off N.E. at 4 P.M. saw a Breach to westward, at 7 took in sail & set the Bysail at 5 P.M. set a top sail to S.E. saw small Breaches at 12 in lat 34 59, N. Lon 40 48, W.

August the 26th sea a cct. 1849

Fine weather & light winds from N.E. at 4 P.M. saw small Breaches at 7 took in sail & hove too at 12 lat 34 46, N. Lon not ascertained

August the 27th sea a cct. 1849

Fine weather & light & halfling, winds the whole day, at 1 P.M. saw a ship bound E. at 12 lat 34 30, Lon 40 40

August the 28th sea a cct. 1849

Fine weather the whole day light winds from S W. to N.W. & squally with light rain, saw two sail bound Eastward, at 12 lat 34 52, Lon 40 23.

August the 29th sea a cct. 1849

Fine weather & light winds from the N.W. at 1 P.M. saw a school of Porpoises, & saw a sail bound to the Eastward. Lat at 12 35 N. Lon 40 16.

August the 30th sea a cct. 1849

Fine weather the whole day, with light winds & halfling from all points, at 2 P.M. kept off S.E. and from N.W. saw a Brig running to the Eastward. The day saw a school of Porpoises, & passed an iron bound cask, & caught 15 Dolphins at 12 in lat 34 24, Lon 40 02.

August the 31st sea a cct. 1849

Good weather the whole day & rain, with squalls from S.E. at 1 P.M. saw a Brigantine running to S.W. at 4 P.M. took in sail & at 5 P.M. set sail to S.E. wind from East. at 10 saw Breaches continued till what they were, at 12 lat 34 04, Lon 40 00

September the 1st sea a cct. 1849

Heavy gales & squalls the whole day, at 12 P.M. took in sail & at 1 P.M. kept the Bysail & set it in at 12 in lat 34 34, Lon not ascertained, wind from East & south E. & very squally, with rain
