Saturday Aug the 17 Commences with fresh breezes
 from the S S E Steering by the wind South
 Middle part the same Ends 30 Sails large
 quantities of gulf weed Lat 33° 02'
 Long 43° 44'

Sunday Aug the 18 Commences with brisk wind
 from S S E Steering by the wind South at 2 AM
 Spoke the Schooner Harvest, real 4 months out
 Clear 36 AM following to seaward Clear at Sunset
 Shortened Sail heading to the South Ends with
 Strong breezes from the S E and veered.
 Lat 31° 52'
 Long in 44° 00'

Monday Aug the 19 first part fresh breezes
 from S E at one 8 AM were Ship to the North East
 At 2 AM were Ship to the Southward
 At 2 AM were Ship to the North East at daylight made
 all Sail Steering by the wind N E Ends Pleasant
 winds variable N E and S S E 80 Ends this 24 hours
 Lat by obs. 32° 33'

Tuesday Aug the 20 first part fresh breezes from
 East and fine weather Steering by the wind North E
 at 2 AM Saw a Sail on our Lee beam at Sunset
 Shortened Sail heading to the North East at daylight made
 all Sail Steering by the wind N E winds from East
 to S S E 80 Ends this 24 hours Lat 33° 38'
 Long 43° 14'

Wednesday Aug 21 All these 24 hours Brisk
 winds from S E Steering by the wind S S E
 Saw one piece of Squid 30 Ends this day
 Lat 34° 34' Long 42° 13' 15"

Thursday Aug the 22 Commences with fine breezes
 from the S E and fine weather Middle part Squally
 with rain latter part fresh breezes from
 S S E and cloudy Steering by the wind N E
 Lat 35° 36' Long in 41° 25'
