

Remarks On Board Brig Medford AD 1851

Monday
April 7th
1851
While Cruising in Port of Prince Bay
Comes in with a light breeze from the Southward
steering North by West at 4 PM boarded the ^{Bay} ~~Port~~ ^{Prince} ~~Bay~~ ^{Bay}
Active from Jackquemet bound to New York
at sunset we was of Cape Lisson kept under sail
all night this morning we was off Cape Donna
Murin six sail of vessels in sight

Tuesday
April 8th
1851
Comes in calm and light breeze from the Westward
steering East at 5 o'clock PM spoke the ^{Principles} of
Principles 4. mas out 59 bbls hump back oil kept
all sail on her steering E. S. East this morning was
off Jerome saw 4 sail of vessels the day ends with
light breeze from the Southward and fair

Wednesday
April 9th
1851
Comes in calm laying night about of the ^{Cazmita} did not
take in sail but kept her by the wind to clear off shore
at 10 PM took a breeze from the Westward the day ends with
a light breeze from the E. S. East and fair weather

Thursday
April 10th
1851
Comes in calm at 4 AM there sprung up a good breeze
from the N. W. West took in sail at sunset this
morning made all sail off Cape St. Nicholas Mole boat
part moderate saw one vessel

Friday
April 11th
1851
Comes in calm at 3 PM took a strong breeze from
the North East took in top gallant sail flying get
mainsail & make stay sail move to heading N. W. West
blew fresh throughout the night this morning
more moderate made all sail at 9 AM saw the
west end of Cuba the day ends with a strong
breeze heading to the westward to go out through
Wayguand Passage saw groups and a schooner

Saturday
Apr 12th
1851
Comes in with a fresh breeze from the north east steering
by the wind heading North by west carried sail all
night at 4 AM tacked ship heading East by South
tacked again at 6 o'clock heading North by West at
8 AM saw the island of Saugua bearing E. S. East
distance 15 miles passed a large barque.

Sunday
Apr 13th
1851
Comes in with a fresh breeze from the North East
steering by the wind head by North by West at 2
PM tacked and stood in within three miles of the
North point of Saugua then tacked to the North
carried sail all night being several times at 10
AM passed the ^{Fluys} to the windward the day
ends with a strong breeze kept the mainsail and top sail

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Monday
Apr 14th
1851
From the passage to Charleston ground
Comes in with a strong breeze from the Eastward
heading north by east all sail set at 6 PM made
the ^{Rentas} or French kept tacked ship to the southward
stood tack and tack all night this morning the
wind hauled to the southward after passing the
keys steered N. N. East the vessel leaking in her
upper works pumped 4000 strokes the last 24 hours
the day ends with a moderate breeze saw hump back

Tuesday
Apr 15th
1851
Comes in with a moderate breeze from the Southward steering
N. N. East took in sail at sunset steering the same course made
sail this morning with a fresh breeze from the S. West at
10 AM brought her to the wind took in top gallant sail &
reefed the topsail heading N. West at 11 AM to north or
heavy sea running

Wednesday
Apr 16th
1851
No. 13. Lat or Long
Comes in with a strong breeze from the S. West laying head to
a heavy sea running and frequent rain squalls it rather
moderated towards sunset the vessel heading N. West this
morning made all sail heading W. S. West with fine
weather

No. 13. Lat or Long

Thursday
Apr 17th
1851
Comes in with a good breeze from the N. West in the
afternoon the wind hauled to the S. West blowing fresh
took in the top gallant sail took in sail at sunset
made short sail this morning with the wind W. S.
West heading South wore ship at 12 M

Lat 72:30 Long 24:59

Friday
Apr 18th
1851
Comes in with a good breeze from the Westward heading by
the wind N. W. West took in sail as usual at sunset
made short sail this morning heading N. N. West the
weather looked bad and a heavy swell from the S. West
saw one or two vessels

Lat 25:34 Long 72:50

Saturday
April 19th
1851
Comes in with the wind from the W. S. West steering
by the wind heading North West took in sail at sunset
made all sail this morning wind the same going at
9 AM boarded the Ship Schultis of Peloton from N. York
12 days bound to Havana saw a whaling ship this AM
