

Remarks On Board Brig Medford

May 2nd
Friday
1851

Charleston Ground

Came in with a fresh breeze from the S West steering by the wind S East at 4 Pm rose ship heading W 3/4 N made sail this morning heading N N West with the wind to the N West blowing fresh before 10 Am the wind hauled to the N East saw three or four vessels

Saturday
May 3rd
1851

Lat 31-04 Lon 75-16

Came in with the wind from the north east steering South at sunset took in sail and came to the wind heading N N West made all sail this morning heading North with a fine breeze and good and pleasant weather

Lat 31-10 Long 75-20

Sunday
May 4th
1851

Came in with the wind from the E N East steering by the wind to the northward took in sail at sunset hauled up the fore sail at 10 Pm lost part the wind from the S East here to

Lon 74-27 Lat 32-08

Monday
May 5th
1851

Came in with a strong breeze from the South East laging head to the S West at 10 Pm it came on to blow heavy hauled up the weather clew of the topsail at 6 Am took it in blowing heavy with rain at 8 the wind hauled to the S West

Lat 32-37 Lon 74-12

Tuesday
May 6th
1851

Came in with a strong gale from the S West here to heading N West at 6 o'clock wore ship to the Southward quite moderate this morning made all sail with the wind North steering West saw a ship steering South

Wednesday
May 7th
1851

Came in with fine weather and pleasant breeze from the N East steering South here to with the wind aback at sunset heading S East made sail this morning steering South saw porpoises & grampuses

Thursday
May 8th
1851

Came in with a pleasant breeze from the northward steering West came to the wind and took in sail at sunset made all sail this morning with the wind to the S East steering by the wind heading E N E saw grampuses and 4 sail of vessels

Friday
May 9th
1851

Came in with a light breeze from the S East heading E N East at sunset took ship and took in sail made all sail this morning heading S West with a light breeze and pleasant weather ends the same saw 5 sail of vessels

Lat 31-33 Lon 75-30

Saturday
May 10th
1851

Came in with a fine breeze from the S East steering by the wind heading South took in sail at sunset made all sail this morning heading S East with fine weather saw three sail of vessels

Lat 30-27 Lon 75-39

Sunday
May 11th
1851

Came in with a light breeze from the E N East steering by the wind heading E S East shortened sail at sunset and came to the wind the wind the same way this morning the weather cloudy

Lat 29-47 Lon 76-06

Monday
May 12th
1851

Came in with a strong breeze from the N E here to heading E S East had a rain & equally night of it made all sail this morning with a light breeze from the S E heading S W by South lost part culm & cloudy

Tuesday
May 13th
1851

Came in with good breeze from the S East heading S West took in sail at sunset made all sail this morning steering the same course took ship at 8 Am heading N East the day ends with fine weather
