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- Janu 11th Moderate breezes and fair weather all thro' 24 hours. we looked out for land and observed no land. A watch below so ends this 24 hours. 1829
- Janu 12th A strong breeze of wind. we made land about 10 o'clock in the morning and called it the main land. Because the old man was out of his mind. we sailed too far to the eastward
- Janu 13th Strong breezes of wind all sail set. we saw a Brig off our weather bow so ends this 24 hours 1829
- Janu 14th Fine and pleasant all sail set the boys making gunn. they was plenty of birds up. Aft flying about the sea so ends this 24 hours 1830
- Janu 15th Head wind all sail set the cooper repairing the oak the mate finished the pulley the hands employed in ships duty so ends this 24 hours 1830
- Janu 16th Fine weather and pleasant all sail set. we sent down the main topgallant sail and bent the old one. John Butler Fisher towed up with Mammal for this species of Duff. so ends this 24 hours 1830
- Janu 17th Fine weather and pleasant all sail set. Ramond was very sick with Consumption and John Butler Fisher had an ill turn at the wheel so ends this 24 hours
- Janu 18th Fine weather and pleasant all sail set. we were making a writing Desk. the hands to work the ships Duty. Mr. Pius painting the ladder. The Blacksmith working at his forge so ends this

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- Janu 19th Fine weather and pleasant all sail set. we made the land of redwood islands in the morning. P. M. We bent our cables to our anchors and looked below them. 4 o'clock we sailed under the lee of the land. And their anchored. and jacked all sail. and the Captain went ashore for timber but no forest and. We took a Boat from over Head. so ends this 24th
- Janu 20th Fine weather and pleasant. 2 boats went ashore in the morning. After dinner all hands but the Cook and steward. the captain went ashore and found 3 men that left the ship. Janny of London. We got 2 boats load of timber they had been on the island 3 months without a drop of water. We found it very hard to buy the 4 biggest animals over the mountains and rocks so ends this 24 hours
- Janu 21st We lowered again and went ashore in the morning for timber and got 2 boats load of timber and took them to the ship before night so ends this 24 hours with good luck and very hard work so ends 1830
- Janu 22nd We went ashore and got 2 boat load of timber. And the even was very sad and weak so ends this 24 hours with good luck. 1830
- Janu 23rd We hoisted up our anchor early in the morning. we made sail and stood for the red bay and the captain shipped them men with us till we go to washoe. so ends this 24 hours. 1830. 1830
- Janu 24th Fine weather and pleasant all sail set. we raised our cables down into the chain room so ends this 24 hours with shales spouting. At night 1830
