

Ship Medicines Boarding 1830

Jan 25<sup>th</sup> Moderate wind and fine weather all sail set and the hands employed in ships duty and we spoke the ship Allegat from New Bedford & went out with 8.00 and 50 barrels the ship Charles out of New Bedford 14 months out with 12.00 & 20 barrels 2 ships in sight towards night we were in sight of several islands. we came into the Bay for Whales. the ship Allegat got 500.00 Barrels and this 24 hours with plenty of gunpowder.

Jan 26<sup>th</sup> Fine weather and pleasant all sail set we saw a ship to the leeward. we got whales we loaded 3 boats and rowed for the whales. but we did not get any fish nor they neither it was they thought of. Santuckett so ends this 24 hours.

Jan 27<sup>th</sup> Fine weather and pleasant all sail set we saw a large school of Whales off our Starboard beam. we squared away our sails and came down to the Whales and lowered 3 boats. the starboard boat got first fish. and killed the Whale. the Larboard Boat killed another. and the Waste Boat killed another. the Starboard boat fastened to another Boat then being faster. and we lost her there. Thus a ship in sight of us so ends this 24 hours.

Jan 28<sup>th</sup> Fine weather and pleasant cutting in our whales and getting under way to try. P. M. we saw a School of Whales off our Star Board. We lowered two boats fixed to lose lay them. we towed the other Boat and the mate killed one and the second mate the other. and the get one of them and we got them along side by night and to finish. there was a ship in sight of us so ends this 24 hours.

Jan 29<sup>th</sup> Little rain. Cutting in our whales. we cut them in before 3 o'clock P. M. trying the same time. and cut up our flukes and junk. and put it in the Boat so ends this 24 hours with good boys and good luck.

Jan 30<sup>th</sup> Fine weather and pleasant. short sail and trying. Cut our fish. and the Specks Lumbered up with catch. There is no Discomt in the starboard for Whaling.

Jan 31<sup>st</sup> Fine weather and trying out our blubber. early in the morning we saw a school of Whales off our Star Board. we lowered all 3 of the boats. and rowed for the Whales the Starboard boat struck 1 of them and killed her. we got her made fast to the ship and she was in before 12 o'clock so ends this 24 hours.
