

Ship Meridian Days Weeks 1830

Apr 11th Fine weather and pleasant A.M. 4th P.M.
 12th Up our lastward anchor And the starboard
 watch went ashore on Liberty. But the wind
 was too low in water so ends this 24 hours

Apr 12th Commences with fine weather and pleasant
 All hands to work at coopersing our oil. At
 11th M. the Danish Captain On Board of the
 Sparrow of Nantucket whiped at Colver.
 Had but not one of them or their vessel
 crew would take his part. I think
 It is not right for the Lord Bred Blubber
 Hunter Captains to carry this way on
 the sea when there is so many ships of
 War to see that there is no such cruel
 Actions Done Except On board of them
 but the Americans fought once for free
 Trade and sailors And why don't they
 show it among themselves. Because they
 want to show them selves. But it is
 no sight for a man to see Another
 One whiped by no means I should say
 What Authority have they got to whipe
 A man But it has been Done on board
 of our ship once or twice But no more
 So ends this 24 hours with finishing stowing
 Down in P.M. Port Power P.

Ship Meridian Days Weeks in 1830

April 13th Fine weather and pleasant All hands to
 Work getting off water. A.M. washed off
 14th The Dicks. P.M. 12 cask on board of
 The old towed ship. so ends this 24 hours

April 14th At M. went Ashore After water. A.D. Blackie
 The ships bones and scraping the waist. P.M.
 The boat Ashore at loading with fruit and
 so another ship in sight of us so ends this 24

April 15th Commences with rainy weather And Light
 16th Breezes the crew at getting off water And
 17th P.M. washing the waist so ends these 24 hours

April 18th Thick and misty and Light Breezes stowed
 19th Some water Down betwixt Dicks And few of
 20th The crew went Ashore A.M. loaded the fore
 Top sail and P.M. fine weather so ends these 24

April 21st Commences with A strong breeze of wind P.M.
 22nd Went Ashore After water. the tide was so
 23rd Strong we could not tow it to the ship

April 24th Very rainy in the morning we went Ashore
 25th for the raft but it drifted away with the
 26th tide we found ash on beach. So it is by
 Having A foolish mate. P.M. one boat
 crew went Ashore on Liberty and we had
 had one day and A/2 paying in moked so
 27th Ends with A strong Breeze of wind 1830. 1830
