

Ship Meridian Collins Henry 1830

Apr 19th Very rainy and thick weather and light breeze
Monday We went ashore in the morning. After some
water P.M. went up royal mast and braked
Out for butter the Captain sold 4 lbs of oil
That fruit which we had but very little of
We had only 1/2 day Liberty ashore at Moked
So ends this 24 hours with plenty of goats but
Tartoo they dont like it. Atoll 1830. 138.0

Apr 20th Commences with fine weather and light
Tuesday breeze. the starboard watch went ashore on
Liberty. the blacksmith went but staid all
night with the young virgins. P.M. the
Ship Pochanua Merchantman 5 months out
from Boston in America so ends the 24 hours
Very bad news it blew a Hurricane out
side of the Islands. So Adieu to the pretty girls

Apr 21st Very ugly weather the boats ashore a breeze
Wednesday for fruit the goats to finish the days
works the blacksmith run away. 1830

Apr 22nd Very rainy and cloudy the rose spruce her
Thursday fore mast her boat come and brought the
news and she lying out side of the harbour

Apr 23rd The captain looking up the Smith
Friday And he could not find him on the Island
We only had 2 half days Liberty on shore
and grugging all the time on Board of the Ship

Ship Meridian Remarks on Bo

Apr 24th We hove up our anchor A.M. bound
Saturday to waroo to see the girls several other
ships have up their anchor bound to the
same port we heard the ship Pochanua
merchantman bound to the same port
P.M. we took in our studding sails

Apr 25th We call'd all hands in the morning to make
Sunday sail at 7. We anchored in the port of waroo
outside of the Harbour. the Captain went
ashore but did not give his men any
Liberty only 2 half days in which we were 24 hours

Apr 26th We hove up our anchor and stee'd for
Monday Japan the Course was W. S. West we got
our anchor on our bow and stow'd our
cables away betwixt Decks the men had
a watch below so ends the 24 hours 1830

Apr 27th Fine weather and pleasant all sail set the
Tuesday breeze but a watch below the ships Course
was the same by South so ends the 24 hours

Apr 28th Fine weather and pleasant all sail set
Wednesday The course West and by South so ends 24 hours

Apr 29th Commences with good weather and a strong
Thursday Breeze of wind from the Northward so ends 24 hours
