we had plenty of company on  
Friday Board of the ship. the mission

watch went ashore on liberty  
the Larboard watch to work  
PM we repaired the ship in  
shores in shore so ends this 24<sup>th</sup>.

Dec 25<sup>th</sup> Fine and pleasant. It was Sunday  
with the people on the shore  
Sated the 2 ships Company went to  
Meeting together and sung  
together so ends this 24<sup>th</sup> hours  
by having plenty of fruit. 1830

Dec 26<sup>th</sup> AM All hands to work All ships Duty  
And the natives bringing off fruit  
Sunday to the crew. And the officers of the ship  
went on shore to examine with the pilot

Dec 27<sup>th</sup> We hoisted up our anchor and stowed  
Monday In night in shore and kept anchor  
because it was so calm we could  
not get out very well so ends 24

Dec 28<sup>th</sup> Very fine and pleasant AM we  
Tues hoisted up our anchor and the pilot  
took us out we backed our main  
yard and discharged the pilot

Dec 29<sup>th</sup> Very fine weather All hands to work 18  
Wed AM ships Duty. AM we had a very smart  
squall took in the topgallant sails  
and hauled up the mainsail PM  
let the mainsails & the main topgallant  
sail so ends this 29<sup>th</sup> hours with good luck

Dec 30<sup>th</sup> All hands to work All ships duty  
Thurs AM we hoisted the spunked we spoke the natives  
and went on board to examine so ends  
this 24<sup>th</sup> hours with good shipmates but
