Thursy
Very fine breeze from the westward
steering E by South P.M. reefed the
Main topsail. And took in the main
topgallant sail. so ends this 24 hours

Janu 21st
Friday
A very good breeze of wind. And we
Carried sail like the David P.M.
We sent out the fore topgallant. 24
studding sail. And main? No. 1831. 18

Janu 22nd
Saturday
A very heavy breeze of wind from
the westward steering E. South East
Right before the wind we reefed the
Main topsail. Close reefed the fore topsail
And put in the mainsail. the foresail
Set so ends this 24 hours. 1831. 1831

Janu 23rd
Sunday
A very heavy breeze of wind and
very cold. we had a watch blow
the ship going 9/2 so ends this 24

Janu 24th
Monday
In the morning the wind died away
we made all sail and set studding
sails fore and aft. P.M. the wind
blew. And we hoisted the
yard up ship so ends this 24. 1831

Janu 25th
Tuesday
The wind came from the NW. and
we steered E and by South. P.M.
we took in the mainsail and set the
Main Staysails. 12 o'clock we made
sail on the ship. so ends this 24

Janu 26th
Wednesday
Commenced with a fair wind
blowing from the westward steering
E and by South. Ship going. At the
Rate of 9/2 not every 24 hours for
5 days and better. P.M. we turned
A reef out of the main topsail.
And set the main & fore topgallant
sails. And the job so ends this 24

Janu 27th
Thursday
Commenced with a strong breeze
of wind. A.M. we reefed the mainsail
And set steering sails Course E
And by South. P.M. reefed the fore
topsail. And took in the fore topgal
lant sail so ends this 24 hours 1831.

Janu 28th
Friday
Fine and pleasant weather
Took a reef out of the main topsail
And set the fore topgallant sail
so ends these 24. 1831
