Sunday Aug 3rd 1851
First Part light breeze from the North
heading Eastward at night were ship. Westward
took in sail Middle Part Moderate breeze
 Latter Part fresh breeze from the Eastward
 heading Northward the land in sight
 So Ends Lat 40-09 N
 Long 32-18 W

32 Monday August 4th 1851
First Part light breeze from the Eastward heading
 Northward Middle Part light winds to baffling
 Latter Part light breeze from the Southward
 heading Eastward the Watch employed in hauling
 out and starting water to some getting the
 Fore Peak halyard block & 2. Poles in
 sight So Ends Lat 40-35 N
 Long 34-00 W

33 Tuesday Aug 5th 1851
First Part light breeze from N^W with fine
 weather heading Eastward 3 sail in sight
 Middle Part spoke the schooner Nube Bruce of
 Providence town Capt Abbott & 4 Months out one
 oil Latter Part fresh breeze from the Westward
 set all sail the land in sight bearing S^W E
 number of sails in sight
 So Ends Lat 40-52 N
 Long 34-14 W

34 Wednesday Aug 6th 1851
First Part fresh breeze from the Westward heading
 Northward came on to rain took in sail
 saw number of ships sails steering Eastward
 Middle Part moderate breeze latter Part fresh
 breeze made sail & steered to the Southward
 the land in sight to the S^W
 saw Grampases & 4 members of ship
 & Birds steering Eastward with all
 three flying Kites set
 So Ends No obs

35 Thursday Aug 7th 1851
First Part fresh breeze at 3 P.M. were ship
 to the N^W wind increasing from the Westward
 Shortened sail saw five black and white ships in
 sight Island of Flores bearing S^W E by Compass
 First 25 miles Middle Part strong wind
 Latter Part the same laying two saw 4 large ships
 steering Eastward and one small sail ship heading
 North So Ends Lat 40-14 N
 Long 31-24 W

36 Friday Aug 8th 1851
First Part strong winds from N^W heading North
 laying two at 3 P.M. the Island of Carvo bearing
 true S^W E by Compass 50 miles Middle Part strong
 Wind latter Part strong Gale saw 4 ships steering
 Eastward all sail set So Ends
 Lat 40-52 N
 Long 31-50 W

37 Saturday Aug 9th 1851
First Part strong Gale from N^W heading N^W
 under storm sails at 3 P.M. by Compass the Island
 of Carvo bearing S^W E by Compass 80 miles
 Middle Part wind shifted to the N^W with rain
 were ship to the S^W further fresh breeze with
 fine weather made sail to Flores South the
 Watch employed So Ends Lat 40-28 N
 Long 31-34 W

38 Sunday Aug 10th 1851
First Part moderate breeze from the N^W steering
 Southward set up the main Topping at 3 P.M.
 saw the land Carvo & Flores bearing S^W E by Compass
 saw 3 sail to Day at night spoke the Barque
 Remrad of Sag Harbor Capt Green & 4 weeks out 40 miles
 there Middle Part light wind latter Part the
 same set all sail & steered Southward
 saw Grampases & 4 others then with out
 success came on board the Island of Flores
 15 miles East bearing S^W E one sail in
 site So Ends
 No obs
