Saturday Feb 14th 1852
First Part light breeze from N by E steering
S by W all sail out. Middle Part light
air & bofing latter part light wind
Part of Dutch Galist steering Eastward
So Ends
Lat 60° 30' 30" N
Long 67° 30' W

Sunday Feb 15th 1852
First Part light wind & increasing from
the South west steering S by W
2 sail in sight, Middle Part sharp
lightning with rain nine bofing with strong
breeze at 2 P.M. from N by E strong Gale
took in sail & hove two leading masts
ward latter Part strong gale at 8 A.M.
at heavy sea, landed in in the harbor
Wester which broke the Bearers and
forward dunnage to the Water Boat &
hove the Boat on on Deck with the
Housing her, Cleared away the Deck
& got all going again, Saw at large
Ship, steering Eastward, So Ends
Lat 60° 37' 30" N
Long 67° 58' 30" W

Monday Feb 16th 1852
First Part moderate wind from N by W
Sea more regular heading N by E
at 3 P.M. moderate breeze Ship
to the Westward at night almost calm
made sail Middle Part light air latter
Part strong wind from S by W steering N by E
Saw at schooner steering Southward
So Ends
Lat 60° 39' 43" N
Long 68° 10' W

Tuesday Feb 17th 1852
First Part fresh Gale from the North
N by W Middle Part strong wind with heavy
squalls of rain latter Part the same
steering N by W Sun at 11 P.M. steering
Southward So Ends
Lat 60° 38' 50" N
Long 68° 05' W

Wednesday Feb 18th 1852
First Part strong Gale from N by W heading
North, at 3 P.M. began to moderate Middle
Part light wind with a large swell on
the Part the same Sun at Ship steering
to the S.E. So Ends
Lat 60° 34' 15" N
Long 68° 10' W

Thursday Feb 19th 1852
First Part light air & bofing heading N by E
Middle Part light wind from East veering South
ward Sun at Ship steering Eastward not far light
latter Part strong wind from the Southward
veering Westward at 9 A.M. wind from the N by W
with heavy thunder & very sharp lightning
to head rain & hail, Saw Water Sports boat
to us Saw at schooner steering Southward
at 11 A.M. Clear wind veering Northward
So Ends
Lat 60° 35' 19" N
Long 68° 57' W

Friday Feb 20th 1852
First Part moderate breeze from N by W at
one P.M. more Ship Westward Middle Part
strong wind from N by E steering N by W latter
Part wind bofing heading N by E So Ends
Lat 60° 35' 42" N
Long 69° 11' W

Saturday Feb 21st 1852
First Part fresh breeze from the North wind
heading N by W Middle Part light wind from
East latter Part moderate breeze from S.E.
steering N by W in the Gulf Stream Saw
3 Sails So Ends
Temperature of the Water and air
Air 67° Water 68°
Lat 60° 35' 50" N
Long 69° 20' W

Sunday Feb 22nd 1852
First Part fresh breeze from the Southward
steering N by W all sail out Middle Part
strong wind with rain shortened sail
steering N by W latter Part strong wind with
rain took in sail & made sail as the weather
required in Green Water Lat 60° 38' 12" N
through the Gulf So Ends Long 69° 55' W
