 Part fresh winds latter Part the same
 heading S.W. by N So Ends Lat by obs 35-41 N
 Long by Chron 52-47 W
 Saturday July 3rd
 First Part strong winds lying two at
 night saw at sea of many Composites
 Middle Part then moderate latter Part
 light breeze from the Westward Steering
 East weather fine So Ends Lat by obs 36-51 N
 Long by Chron 52-51 W
 Sunday July 4th
 First Part light air from the Westward
 Steering East at night at Black Sea and had
 some of him for supper at night took
 in sail Middle Part light wind latter
 Part fresh breeze kept off S.W. by E under
 a fine sail saw at large ship Steering
 Eastward So Ends Lat by obs 37-17 N
 Monday July 5th Long by Chron 51-35 W
 First Part moderate breeze from West
 Steering E at night by day Middle
 Part fresh breeze latter Part the same
 Steering S.W. saw 2 South Caled three
 Composites at 10 at all steered S.W. wind at
 West So Ends Lat by obs 38-04 N

 S.W. one sail in sight Steering Eastward
 at night took in sail & by day Middle
 Part at 8 spoke the Barque Parker Cook
 of Providence Capt Cook & Men out 20th
 of firm then Boat came on Board after letters
 run to the Eastward in company with
 Part strong wind attended with thunder
 and lightning and rain
