steering W. by N. Middle Part light air
from the East the same Employe in fitting
tugging to End Latt by obs 33-00-00

Tuesday July 20th
First Part light air from the Eastward
steering W. by N. all sail out Employe
as before, at ship in sight, Middle Part
Calme latter Part light breeze at South
steering W. by N. Employe in fitting tugging
to End Latt by obs 33-15-00
Long by Chron 45-15-10

Wednesday July 21st
First Part fine weather all day Set
steering W. by N. at night short land sail
Middle Part light breeze latter Part
the same Set all sail steering W. by N.
Latt at new head W. by N. to the flying jib
to End Latt by obs 33-28-00
Long by Chron 45-25-30

Thursday July 22nd
First Part fresh breeze from W. steering W. by N.
all sail set, 2 sail in sight, at night
short land sail Middle Part fresh breeze
latter Part strong wind from West to squally
one sail in sight to End
Latt by obs 34-08-00
Long by Chron 47-41-10

Friday July 23rd
First Part fresh breeze from West heading
W. by N. one sail in sight, at night fresh
in sail, Middle Part light breeze latter Part
light wind from the North steering W. by N.
all sail set to End
Latt by obs 34-39-00
Long by Chron 47-54-10

Saturday July 24th 1852
First Part light air heading Westward Middle
Part Calme latter Part fresh breeze from S. E.
steering Westward, saw Grampus to End
Latt by obs 34-35-00
Long by Chron 48-37-10

Sunday July 25th
First Part light wind from S. E. all sail out
Middle Part at 7 spoke an English Barge
Bound for London, latter Part fresh breeze
from S. E. Middle Part at 11 still under this
to the Southward to End Latt by obs 35-05-00
Long by Chron 48-54-10

Monday July 26th
First Part fresh breeze from West steering
W. by N. the wind Southward, at night shortened
sail Middle Part light wind latter Part
fresh breeze heading South to End
Latt by obs 35-10-00
Long by Chron 48-09-10

Tuesday July 27th
First Part light wind to Baffling heading
Southward, one sail in sight to the
Westward, at night took in sail Middle
Part Calme latter Part the same 11 Brig
in sight to End Latt by obs 35-40-00

Wednesday July 28th
First Part light air to Baffling heading W.
Middle Part light wind latter Part the
same heading Southward wind from the
Westward to End Latt by obs 35-45-00
Long by Chron 48-10-10

Thursday July 29th
First Part moderate breeze from the
Westward heading Southward, at night
shortened sail Middle Part light wind
latter Part moderate breeze heading Southward
to End Latt by obs 35-00-00
Long by Chron 47-57-10

Friday July 30th
First Part fine breeze from the Westward heading
Southward, Middle Part light moderate Part
much the same at 10 it came on a very
heavy tempest with hard rain, spin all round the
Compass took in sail to End
