 ship to the S. 2nd Part ship to the East
 Middle Part moderate breeze latter Part
 the same at 8 o'clock saw a large whale
 longed a chart whale perceived the
 the boat came on board of the whale with
 vessel so ends
 Batt by obs 53-18 m
 Long by thro 49-54 m

63 Tuesday Aug 11th
 First Part fine weather at one o'clock
 second Part wind not strike came
 on board of the ship with the ship
 Middle Part light winds latter Part fine
 weather made sail to starboard of the
 at 7 o'clock saw a whale at short range
 at short of large, lowered at struck
 one & killed him so ends
 Batt by obs 53-18 m
 Long by thro 49-54 m

64 Wednesday Aug 12th
 First Part fine weather at 2 o'clock
 got the whale at long sight at 4 o'clock
 began to cut got the head off the
 1st Part of the body, Middle Part
 by by latter Part fine weather the wind
 from S.W. heading 18 so ends
 Batt by obs 53-58 m
 Long by thro 48-15 m

65 Friday Aug 13th
 First Part light wind & baffling some
 rain at 3 o'clock began to sail. Middle
 Part sailing latter Part the same wind
 from W.S.W. heading 18 so ends
 Batt by obs 54-02 m
 Long by thro 48-15 m

66 Saturday Aug 14th
 First Part light wind from West
 employed in sailing at night were
 ship to the East. Middle Part
 sailing latter Part the same
 wind ship to the Northward
 so ends
 Batt by obs 54-12 m
 Long by thro 47-57 m

65 Day out
 Sunday Aug 15th 1854
 On the Western Ground.
 First Part moderate breeze from S.W. at
 5 o'clock finished sailing at 8 o'clock were
 ship to the W.S.W. at night took in
 sail Middle Part moderate breeze latter
 Part fresh breeze steering by the wind S.W.
 so ends
 Batt by obs 53-20 m
 Long by thro 47-08 m

68 Monday Aug 16th
 First Part fresh breeze from West heading S.W.
 at 8 o'clock ship lay up S.W. Middle Part
 Moderate breeze latter Part the same wind from
 the North steering 18 & employed in stowing
 down oil so ends
 Batt by obs 53-03 m

69 Tuesday Aug 17th
 First Part fine weather at night finished
 stowing & took in sail & by the way
 Middle Part light winds latter Part the
 same steering 18 by S.W. ends
 Batt by obs 53-58 m
 Long by thro 45-18 m

70 Wednesday Aug 18th
 First Part light winds from S.W. steering
 18 by S.W. Middle Part light air latter Part
 the same repaired the Main sail & set it
 steering 18 by S.W. ends
 Batt by obs 52-18 m
 Long by thro 45-55 m

71 Thursday Aug 19th
 First Part light air from S.W. steering 18 by S
 at 6 o'clock wind from S.W. Middle Part light wind
 latter Part the same took ship to the S.W.
 took in the harbor boat and exalted her over
 to spitting her. saw a brig steering Southward
 so ends
 Batt by obs 51-49 m
 Long by thro 45-38 m

72 Friday Aug 20th
 First Part light wind from E by S at
 6 o'clock took ship to the S.E. Middle Part
 moderate breeze latter Part the same
 took in the Water Boat & exalted her
 over so ends
 Batt by obs 52-20 m
 Long by thro 44-53 m
