The 24 hours begins with fine trade breeze & smooth weather steering
South Franklin off our Starboard from steering the same at 1 PM
we lowered aft. blackfish without success some on board & then
for course Middle & latter part of the day fresh breeze & passing clouds
steering NNE saw several strong sails watch employed in washing
there clear the day, new fresh breeze
Set in by 12.15 or long in by Chronometer 24.10 West

48 Remarks on Tuesday even 25th 1845
The 24 hours begins with fresh trade breeze & passing clouds under all
magnifying sail steering NNE the 24 hours begins off our lee quarter steering the
same watch employed in washing there clear at 6 PM the fresh breeze
we middle & latter part of the day fine breeze & passing clouds under all sail
steering NNE watch employed in this duty the day, new with moderate
breeze Set in by 10.00 or long in by Chronometer 23.20 West

49 Remarks on Wednesday even 26th 1845
The 24 hours begins with moderate breeze & passing clouds under all sail
steering NNE watch employed in this duty the Franklin off our lee quarter
steering the same middle part of the day fine breeze & cloudy at 5 PM
steering NNE latter part of the day moderate breeze & rain by 11.16
at 6 AM steering NE NNE at 7 saw a whale started ship for him he
brought the head fin back at 11 hauled up rearing at Merriam
lowered aft. blackfish & got one to the Starboard boat
Set in by 8.05 or long in by Chronometer 22.05 West

50 Remarks on Thursday even 27th 1845
The 24 hours begins with moderate breeze & cloudy weather
all hands employed in blackfishing at 1 PM got our fish on board
& steering NE NNE the Franklin off our lee bow steering the same & one
ship in sight at 2 PM we hauled our blackfish board & mined
the blubber at 6 the Franklin spoke us & we both steered NE NNE
middle part of the day fine breeze latter part moderate breeze & rain
from 8 AM to South by East at fire & boiled out our blackfish
blubber the day, new light winds
Set in by 7.11 or long in by ~~Chronometer~~ Chron 21.00 West

51 Remarks on Friday even 28th 1845
The 24 hours begins with A moderate breeze from the South steering
to the NE by the wine Franklin steering the same at 2 PM we took
a squall of wind & rain from the Eastward took in all sail when the
squall passed we made sail again middle & latter part of the day light
winds from SE NNE to SE NNE under all sail steering by the wine
heading up from 1 PM to 1 PM watch employed on board about the
rigging the Franklin off our weather bow at 11 AM saw a strong sail off
our weather bow steering to the North the day, new light winds & pleasant
weather Set in by 6.24 or long in by Chronometer 21.13 West

52 Remarks on Saturday even 29th 1845
The 24 hours begins with light winds from SE NNE & fine pleasant
weather under all sail steering by the wine heading NNE the Franklin
off our weather bow steering the same watch employed in this duty one
strong sail off our weather bow steering to the North at 2 PM the wine
breeze from E NNE steering NNE at 6 PM the 24 hours begins
Hazzard came on board at 9 went back again we both steered NNE
middle & latter part of the day moderate winds some thunder & lightning
at 10 AM the wine hauled NE light winds & cloudy weather
Set in by 8.35 or long in by the same 20.10 West

53 Remarks on Sunday even 30th 1845
The 24 hours begins with light winds from NE & nearly calm steering by
the wine heading NNE watch employed in washing there clear Franklin
off our lee bow steering the same middle & latter part of the day light
winds & calm by 11.16 heading from NNE to NE the day, new
light winds Set in by 8.20 or long in by Chronometer 21.55 West

54 Remarks on Monday December 1st 1845
The 24 hours begins with light winds from NE & fair weather under
all sail steering by the wine heading up NNE by the Franklin
off our lee bow steering the same the wine hauled NNE & took
him at Middle & latter part of the day light winds from the
NNE & fair weather & passing clouds steering by the wine one strong
sail in sight to windward the Franklin off our weather bow watch employed
in this duty the day, new with A fine breeze
Set in by 11.51 or long in by Chronometer 21.30 West
