

367 Remarks on Friday October 9th 1848

the 24 hours begins with light winds from the westward & thick smoky weather under all sail steering for westward harbor watch employed in ship duty several sails in light at 4 feet 2 PM saw Black Island bearing W & by compass at 4 miles the N.E. part of Black Island bore west distance 8 miles at 8 PM the wind shifted to the north & went round to the E. & S. & at 10 PM made all sail at 8 to 10 ship & head at 10 at 7 PM at 10 PM in thick foggy weather & light winds from N.W. at 4 feet 10 at 11 PM we came to anchor 2 miles from Beacon Point in 11 fathoms water & fired for a pilot & at 12 PM came to us from the point at Beacon Point was back our anchor & made sail & then by the wind backing S.W. & E. thick fog to cover the day

the 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from N.W. & at thick fog steering by the wind backing S.W. & E. at 4 PM the fog lifted & we took ship & then by the wind to the N.W. & fired 4 guns for a pilot saw gyphard & cuttubush & the North Star & at 5 PM plenty of vessels but no pilot steering over for Wheeler Island by the wind backing N.W. at 7 PM took ship to the N.W. point light bearing N.W. & at 11 PM the wind shifted to the west & began to freshen up & blew on shore over for gyphard light shot out at 10 at 11 PM was thick & stood over for Wheeler Island at 12 PM was thick & stood over for gyphard blowing heavy from N.W. saw plenty of vessels at 10 at 11 PM got over to gyphard & at the light to the far top allenthead head for a pilot at 11 got a pilot on board from cuttubush & we made sail & began to beat round the horn & by 12 PM wind moderating by 1 mile the day ends with fair weather under all no. 100 sail beating to windward

the 24 hours begins with strong winds from N.W. & fair weather under all no. 100 sail beating to the westward at 7 PM came to anchor in front harbor & fired sail
