Wednesday the 28 this day commences with light wind from the Sth steering by the wind with all sail out ~~at~~ the middle part same latter part part of to the Pth so ends these 24 hours jiggery

Thursday the 29 this day commences with light wind from the Sth steering by the wind to the Pth with all sail out made the ice at 4 o'clock to the middle part spoke the Lemmeny and Algal latter part bore for whales so ends these 24 hours steering Nth

Friday the 30 this day commences with light wind from the Pth steering down the ice bore for whales saw ship in sight & middle part latter part jiggery spoke the fava so ends these 24 hours

Saturday the 31 this day commences with light winds from the Sth steering by the wind with all sail out spoke the hibernia of A.P.B. & middle part the Otogail in sight latter part spoke the same ship in sight so ends these 24 hours jiggery

Monday the 1st this day commences with light winds from Sth steering by the wind saw the Pth weather sailing middle part the ice in sight latter part spoke for ship and saw seven bore the harbor and bore boat 10.95 along the ice so ends these 24 hours in the la

Tuesday the 2nd this day commences with strong wind from the Sth steering by the wind bore to the Pth & middle part the same latter part spoke the Arctic heating up the ice so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday the 3rd this day commences with strong winds from the Sth steering by the wind with all sail out middle part the same latter part the same jiggery spoke the Arctic second so ends these 24 hours

Thursday the 4th this day commences with light wind from the Sth steering to the Pth with the Arctic & middle part the same laying back latter part steering to the Pth with all sail out spoke the Arctic so ends these 24 hours

Friday the 5th this day commences with light winds from the Sth steering & with all sail out the land 20 miles of spoke the cherry Ann of A.P.B. & middle part steering in to the land there sail in sight bore for whales
