S took the anchor to that of the land the boat
up the bay at 4 P.M. the ship in three fathoms
and the wind blowing strong on shore middle
part the wind held the S the ship at anchor
latter part rainy so ends these 24 hours

the 27

this day commenced with light winds
from the S steering by the wind to the
middle part the same the land the middle
part the ship in sight the natives
along side spoke the same Galpide Yene
so ends these 24 hours

Monday
the 28

this day commenced with light
winds from the S steering in to
the bay to anchor sent both anchor
these ship at anchor in the bay
in sight out side strong tide set out

this commenced with strong breezes
from the N steering by the wind under
top sails at 4 P.M. spoke the
St George middle part strong breezes latter
part single reefed the top sails the St George in
sight so

ends these 24 hours in Lett 10-56

November the 6

2 this day commenced with strong breezes
from the N steering by the wind under
single reef top sails the St George in sight
killed a Pig killed the same latter part
stayed floor and spoke let up one more
so ends these 24 hours

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Friday

November the 7 1851

3 commenced with the strong breezes
from the N steering by the wind
under top sails two ships in sight middle
part the same spoke the top sail latter
part rainy one ship in sight
so ends these 24 hours

commenced with strong breezes from
the N steering by the wind under double
reef top sails spoke the middle part the same took in
gib latter part set the gib sailing

so ends these 24 hours
