this day commences with light breezes from the S.E. steering in to the land the Siden Holland getting of water the natives came of with coconuts and old hats chiddls part coming laying back at 11 steering by the wind once all sail latter part the same two ship in sight so ends these 24 hours

this day commences with light breezes two ship in sight coming with the S. D. Holland chiddls part the same latter part fine weather so ends these 24 hours

Friday the 12

this day commences with light breezes from the S.E. steering by the wind with sail out to the S.E. chiddls part saw the S. D. Holland have fore boats down Clark Island in sight of the S. D. beam latter part fine weather the S. D. in sight so ends these 24 hours

Saturday the 13

this day commences with light breezes steering to the S.E. under all sail chiddls part saw the land reaches island shortened sail latter part.

had 65 ft S spoke the St Gorge boiling the natives came of to trade so ends these 24 hours

Sunday the 14

this day commences with light winds from the S.E. steering to the S.E. under all sail chiddls part saw two ship short sail latter part made sail two ship in sight so ends these 24 hours

this day commences with light winds from the S.E. steering by the wind all sail out spoke the S. D. chiddls part fine shortened sail latter part the same heading to the Westward rattling the main rigging so ends these 24 hours

this day commences with light winds from the N.W. steering by the wind to the S.W. under all sail one ship in sight chiddls part under all sail latter part saw a ship ahead so ends the day

this day commences with light breezes from the S.E. steering by the wind to the S.W. under all sail chiddls part took in the fore top gallant sail
