saw Heilbers and the ice so ends these 24 h

Wednesday the 7
this day commenced with light
breezes from the S.W. stirring along the ice
saw whales and got a stick
took him along side cutting him in
middle part the same latter part
boiling along side the ice so ends
the 24 hours

Thursday the 8
this day commenced with light
breezes from the S.W. stirring along side
ice boiling middle part fog of latter
part the same so ends these 24 hours

Friday the 9
this day commenced with
strong breezes from S.W. stirring by
wind saw whales and got one took him
along side but him lay middle
part the same so ends these 24 hours

Saturday the 10
this day commenced
strong breezes from the S.W. stirring
first day main top sail and fore sail
boiling and stirring down middle
part the same latter part fog of
new ship in sight
so ends these 24 h

Sunday the 11
this day commenced with
light breezes from the S.W. stirring
by the wind to the S.W. under 6 last
main top sail and fore sail fog of
boiling and stirring down middle and
latter part the same so ends these 24 hours

Monday the 12
this day commenced with light
breezes from the S.W. stirring main top sail
and fore sail boiling and stirring down
middle part the same spoke the edmark
latter part toward for whale
so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday the 13
this day commenced with
light breezes from the S.W. stirring
by the wind all sail out cool down
spoke the edmark latter part
part the latter part stirring down sailing
so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday the 14
this day commenced with
strong breezes from the S.W. took in fore
and main top sails rising middle part the
same spoke the edmark two ship sight
latter part saw three Doggers and one
ship boiling so ends these 24 hours

Thursday the 15
this day commenced with light
breezes from the S.W. stirring by the
wind set the fore and main top sails
spoke the Black Eagle boiling head
saw 40 whales a day for week
