

Thursday the 15 July

1852

Saw dead whale two far saw raising
middle part the same saw others and took him
along side but him lay till morning latter
part cutting saw the whole stored in the fire
so ends these 24 hours

Friday the 16

this day commenced with light
breezes from the S.W. steering by the wind
and double reef top sails saw whales heard
up the straits saw 8 ship boiling to side
our left half middle stowing the fore hold
latter part five at 10 AM. Commenced
blowing and blew again from S.W. took
in the fore and main top sails and
lost reef the main pulled the fore sail
so ends these 24 hours

Saturday the 17

this day commenced with
a Gale from the S.W. laying under lost
reef main top sail - Cool down the land
in sight saw ship in sight middle
part the same latter part commenced
boiling foggy so ends these 24 hours

Sunday the 18

this day commenced with
light breezes from the S.W. steering
by the wind under lost reef top sails
boiling five ship in sight all boiling
in middle part the same latter part
cooled down saw whales toward
the but got none down on board and
stowed down so ends these 24 hours

Monday the 19

this day commenced with strong
breezes from the S.W. steering by the wind
under double reef top sails spoke the ~~Barren~~ ~~Barren~~ ~~Barren~~ ~~Barren~~
and the Goodwin turning boiling to side
of the whale in shore and having one whale
along side middle part latter part saw
for whales so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday the 20

this day commenced with
light breezes from the S.W. steering by
the wind all sail out saw whales
square for them middle part the same
latter part saw whales and got
one took him along side and commenced
cutting whales all round so
so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday the 21

this day commenced with
a Gale from the S.W. laying under
sails cutting the land on a steamer
and heard 11 L. and 10 M. whales
middle part the same latter part
boiling so ends these 24 hours

Thursday the 22

this day commenced with
light breezes from the S.W. steering by the
wind to the S.W. under double reef top sails
spoke the ~~Clasig~~ ~~Clasig~~ ~~Clasig~~ ~~Clasig~~ ~~Clasig~~ ~~Clasig~~ ~~Clasig~~ ~~Clasig~~
the Moringo at anchor cutting latter
part saw whales saw the M. take in
