breezes from the N. steering by the wind
all sail set setting of shore middle
part spoke the shore ground and heard
hoars latter part steering by the wind
to the N. E. so ends these 24 hours

Thursday the 29

this day commences with
strong breezes from the N. steering
by the wind under double reef top sails
which fog chide part toward for
schooner's shore to foggy latter part
foggy so ends these 24 hours
