January 7 1855

This day commences with strong
gale from the E under blast Reef men
Topsail. Her ship at 12 O'clock
later part the wind abates so ends
the 24 hours

Monday 8
This day commences with strong
gale from the eastward at 2 P.M.
later part the same so ends the 24 hours

Tuesday 9
This day commences with
strong gale from the E strong by
the wind at 10 P.M. later part the
same so ends the 24 hours

Wednesday 10
This day commences with
strong gale from the E strong by
the wind middle part the same
later part more moderate strong the fore part
And gale so ends the 24 hours

Thursday 11
This day commences with
light breeze from the E strong by
the wind middle part the same later part
light breeze strong the middle so ends
the 24 hours

Friday 12

This day commences with
strong breeze from E & strong by
the wind under sail Reef Tabbie
middle part the same later part lighter
breeze so ends the 24 hours

Saturday 13
This day commences with
strong breeze from the E & strong by

so ends the 24 hours

Sunday 14
This day commences
with strong breeze from the E & strong by
the wind under sail middle part the same
later part the same so ends the
24 hours

Monday 15
This day commences
with light breeze from the E & strong by
the wind under sail middle part the same
later part the same so ends the
24 hours

This day commences with light
breeze from E & strong by
the wind under sail middle part the same
later part the same so ends the
24 hours
