This day commenced with a light air from the S.W. steering S.E. by W. with all sail out. Middle part at 5 P.M. saw 4 sperm whales and heard for them but got none. To bed. Later part the same so ends this 24 hours

Sunday March 3^d

This day commenced with a light air from the S.W. steering S.E. by W. with all sail out. Middle part land air. Light on the Starboard beam later part the same so ends this 24 hours

Monday March 4th

This day commenced with a light wind from the S.W. steering S.E. by W. with all sail out. Middle part the same so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday March 5th

This day commenced with a light air from the S.W. steering S.E. by W. with all sail out. Middle part the same so ends this 24 hours
