This day commences
With a light wind from the S. E. blowing
By the wind with full sail out the water
Have played in - at duty better. Did the
Same so ends then 24 hours.

Thursday 20

This day commencing with light, shifted from E. to S. E. blowing off shore with all sail out Middle Part the Tamer so winds 24 knots.

Friday, 22

This day commenced
with a light wind from the N.E. Thence
the wind with all sail out the next morn-
ing by Middle Port, Strong Wind to
wards the N.E. sails
