

Ureanill Dec 4th 1837

This day is a very pleasant day Sunday I shall
not go to meeting to day I was 14 years old last
September 30 I shall not say my prayer for
2 months I shall read the Bible to day and
joined in falling prayer this morning
This is a very pleasant day another week has past
and with it another Sabbath a day of rest we shall
not have any prayer this morning as my father
is not at home he is in Preston. This is the beginning
of another week another week has past and gone and
with it has brought another Sabbath another day
of rest as father is over the river to meeting
to day as father is out west along with his father
this will be to day as I shall read & this is the
beginning of another week as I have said my prayer
and read & I shall keep this day holy father is at
home to day & ends these 24 hours & ends this
month and this year I shall begin
a new year and this will do for this year

I wrote one Letter to Aunt Fann
Smith

Oct 30th 1837

This beginning of a new year 14 years have past
and gone sending my remembrance a few more
riding and setting down and I shall go from thence
no matter shall return as another week has past
and gone and with it some of our unconverted
friends who have not said my prayer this morning
I must be short and say more so I must close for
now saying I shall not pray to day that will do
for to day as I have said my prayer I shall write
a little more I shall not go to meeting
to day so ends these 24 hours as I have not
said my prayer I shall write a little before
I pray another Sabbath has come I shall not go
to meeting to day as I have said my prayer I will write
a little more I shall not pray to day & ends
these 24 hours this is the beginning of another
Sabbath I shall not pray to day nor go
to meeting to day father is again
to meeting to day I shall say my
prayer to day father is a
reading about the monuments to day how they have declared
as agents the United States I should think it was time
we were up and doing if that is the case James is out
west he likes there very much he says that it is a
very pretty place many is going out west in the spring

Father is going out west in the spring I think we shall
go in summer or in the fall this will do for to
day & ends these 24 hours I shall not write
no more on this page
