Saturday August the 1

this day begins with light breeze and pleasant weather from the N ship heading in the wind on starboard tack watch employed in ship duty lowered the boats for practice middle part calm latter part calm broke out for stops and water so ends this day

Sunday the 2

this day begins with light breeze and pleasant weather from the N ship heading watch employed in picking up animals gaming with the Mary Wheeler off New Bedford captain Franken middle part light breeze latter part light breeze and pleasant weather from the N ship heading S by E all sail set set the fore topmast shudding sail & sails in sight so ends this day

Monday the 3

this day begins with light breeze and pleasant weather from the N ship heading S by E all sail set 2 sails in sight and four of the Western Islands in sight fragal and Pies-sank grass at gorges middle part light breeze latter part light breeze and pleasant weather from the N ship heading S by W saw St Michael so ends this day

Tuesday the 4

this day begins with light breeze and pleasant weather from the N ship steering S by W all sail set watch employed in work about the ship middle part light breeze latter part light breeze and pleasant weather from the N ship steering S by W all sail set so ends this day

Tallman Bound on Walsingham Voyage August the 1

Wednesday the 5

this day begins with light breeze and pleasant weather from the N ship steering S by W all sail set watch employed to work in the rigging middle part light breeze latter part light breeze from the N ship steering S by W all sail set watch employed in scraping the decks so ends this day

Lat 34.14 Long 25.26

Thursday the 6

this day begins with light breeze and pleasant weather from the E S E ship steering S by W all sail set watch employed in scraping the decks middle part light breeze and rain latter part light breeze and squally from the E S E ship heading S by W broke out for 3 barrels of meat so ends this day

Friday the 7

this day begins with light breeze and pleasant weather from the E S E ship steering S by W all sail set watch employed in work about the ship middle part fresh breeze latter part strong breeze from the E ship heading S by W all sail set one sail in sight watch employed in picking over potatoes so ends this day

Lat 30.30 Long 24.42

Saturday the 8

this day begins with strong breeze and good weather from the E ship heading S by W all sail set watch employed in picking over potatoes one sail in sight middle part fresh breeze latter part strong breeze and good weather from the E ship steering S by W all sail set broke out for cod fish sugar and molasses one sail in sight so ends this day
