this day begins with light breeze and good weather from the E S E ship heading S all sail set one sail in right watch employed in work about the ship middle and latter part light breeze and good weather from the S E ship heading S W by S all sail set employed in making spinnaker sails this day Lat 19:00 Long 30:19

Friday the 11
this day begins with light breeze and good weather from the E S E ship heading S by W all sail set 3 sails in right saw humpbacks employed in making spinnaker middle and latter part strong breeze from the E ship heading S by E all sail set 4 sails in right saw the Island of Trinidad bearing E S E 50 miles this day Lat 21:00 S

Saturday the 12 Long 29:09 W
this day begins with fresh breeze and good weather from the E N E ship heading S E by S all sail set 4 sails in right watch employed in making spinnakers the Island in sight middle and latter part fresh breeze and good weather from the E N E ship heading S E by S all sail set look out for water 4 sails in sight so ends this day
