middle and latter part strong breeze and  
squally with from the S W ship heading S E  
by S under short sail Lat 37:20  
so ends this day Long 21:24

Thursday the 8  
this day begins with strong breeze and  
rugged weather from the S W ship heading  
S E by S all sail set off Cape good  
hope latter part light breeze and good weather  
from the E S E ship heading S by W all sail  
set watch employed in mending the fore  
topsail so ends this day Lat 37:30  
Long 20:39

Friday the 9  
this day begins with light breeze and good  
weather from the E S E ship heading S by W  
all sail set watch employed in mending  
the foretopsail middle and latter part fresh breeze  
and good weather from the E S E ship heading S  
by E all sail set one sail in sight tent fore and main  
topsail so ends this day Lat 39:45  
Long 21:27

Saturday the 10  
this day begins with fresh breeze and good weather  
from the E S E ship heading S by E all  
sail set one sail in sight saw plenty of fin  
backs whales middle and latter part light breeze  
and good weather from the E ship heading  
S E by S all sail set  
so ends this day Lat 41:20  
Long 23:40

## Tallman Bound on a Whaling Voyage.

Sunday the 11  
this day begins with fresh breeze and good  
weather from the E ship heading  
S E by S all sail set middle and latter  
part fresh breeze and good weather from  
the E S E ship heading S E by E all sail  
set one sail in sight Lat 42:15  
so ends this day Long 26:16 E

Monday the 12  
this day begins with light breeze and good  
weather from the E S E ship heading  
S E by E all sail set saw plenty of  
finbacks whales middle and latter part light  
breeze and good weather from the E ship heading  
S S E all sail set one sail in sight broke  
out for water so ends this day  
Lat 43:20

Tuesday the 13 Long 25:19  
this day begins with light breeze and good  
weather from the E ship heading S by E  
all sail set one sail in sight middle  
and latter part strong breeze and good  
weather from the S W ship heading S E  
took in the foretop gallant sail and  
gaff topsail so ends this day  
Lat 44:40 Short

Wednesday the 14 Long 30:45 East  
this day begins with strong breeze and  
rugged weather from the S E ship heading  
S E by E single reef topsails set and  
courses saw whales good fresh breeze middle and  
latter part a gale from the S S E ship heading  
two double reef maintop sail and fore sail  
heading E S E  
so ends this day
