Tuesday the 27

this day begins with light breeze and good weather from the NW ship steering ESE & all sail set studding sails both sides middle and latter part light breeze and good weather from the NW ship steering ESE & all sails set broke out for bread and flour so ends this day

Wednesday the 28

this day begins with light breeze and good weather from the NW ship steering ESE & by E half E all sail set saw plenty of finback whales turned the cook out and put in a new one middle and latter part strong breeze from the NW ship heading ESE & by E half E made the Island of St. Paul lowered the boat and went a fishing so ends this day

Thursday the 29

this day begins with a gale and rugged weather from the NW ship heading ESE & under double reef fore and maintop sail and foresail all hands employed in cleaning fish and salted some middle and latter part strong breeze from the NW ship heading ESE & under double reef topsails and foresail Lat 38:15 Long 80:15

Friday the 30

this day begins with strong breeze and rugged weather from the NW ship steering ESE & under double reef topsails fore and courses middle and latter part strong breeze and rugged weather from the NW ship heading ESE & under topsails and courses and main topgallant sail Lat 37:22 Long 84:45 so ends this day
