this day begins with strong breeze and squally weather from the N S W ship steering E under double reef fore topsail single reef main and maintop gallant sail middle and latter part strong breeze and rainy weather from the S W ship steering E under short sail so ends the day

Monday the 2

this day begins with strong breeze and good weather from the S S W ship steering East under all sail got a fore fair middle and latter part fresh breeze and good weather from the S W ship steering East all sail set studding sails set so ends the day
