This day begins with strong breeze and squally weather from the S W ship steering E by S double reef topsails and courses middle and latter part strong gale from the S W ship flying two under close reef of main topsail so ends this day

This day begins with gale and rough weather from the S ship heading E by S under close reef fore and main topsail and fore sail middle and latter part fresh breeze and good weather from the S W ship steering E by S all sail set broke out for water so ends this day
