ship laying two a boiling spoke the
ship Portland of New York bound to
Melbourne middle and latter part strong
gale and rugged weather from the W ship
laying two a boiling so ends this day

Thursday the 14
this day begins with a gale and rugged
weather from the W ship laying two a
boiling middle and latter part light
breeze and good weather ship double reef
topsails and foresail a boiling
so ends this day Lat 38° 15'
Long 115° 37'

this day begins with light breeze and good
weather from the W ship to the Southward
double reef topsails and foresail finished
boiling latter part strong breeze from the S W
all hands employed in stowing down oil
fat down 5 & barrels started 1 cask of bread
rounds this day

Saturday the 16
this day begins with strong breeze and
good weather from the S W ship steering
S E by E all sail set broke out
for water and flour middle and latter
part fresh breeze and good weather from the
S W ship steering S E all sail set
so ends this day

Sunday the 17
this day begins with light breeze and
good weather from the S ship heading
E by S all sail set one sail in
sight middle and latter part light breeze
and good weather from the S E ship
heading S W all sail set broke out for
molasses and pickel onions
so ends this day Lat 39° 20'
Long 118° 57' E

Monday the 18
this day begins with fresh breeze and
good weather from the S E ship heading
E by S all sail set six finbacks whales
middle and latter part light breeze and good
weather from the S E ship heading
S E by E all sail set
so ends this day Lat 39° 10' S
Long 121° 7' E
