

Barge Midas Round the S Islands

Friday the 12

this day begins underweigh with a good breeze from the N.E. bound to Toabia three men in irons latter part strong breeze and squally running down the bay come to anchor at Toabia took the men out of irons so ends this day

Saturday the 13

this day begins at anchor at Toabia all hands employed in getting up potatoes got them all up broke out a cask of bread took on board 80 barrels of potatoes latter part got underweigh and stood out of the passage bound to Wahoo so ends this day

Sunday the 14

this day begins with a good breeze from the N.E. ship steering off by N. bound to Wahoo Mosea in sight and Chibbee in sight latter part light breeze heading down for Wahoo saw sperm whales and got one Rainier Molahie in sight so ends this day

Monday the 15

this day begins with light breeze the islands in sight all hands employed in cutting in the whale and finished latter part light breeze started fire in the try works saw the Massachusetts of merchant water in sight so ends the day

Tuesday the 16

this day begins with light breeze Wahoo in sight gaining with the ship Massachusetts employed in boiling latter part light breeze laying off and on at Wahoo the captain ashore the rest employed in boiling out the whale so ends the day

Wednesday the 17

this day begins with fresh breeze the ship laying off and on at Wahoo the captain came on board and started for Attahjee employed in boiling out the whale latter part light breeze ship steering W by N finished boiling bound to Attahjee so ends this day
