This day commences with light breeze and foggy from the W & ship laying in the ice close reef mainmast sail set employed in boiling both part strong breeze and snow storm from the W & ship in the ice under close reef mainmast sail finished boiling

so ends the day

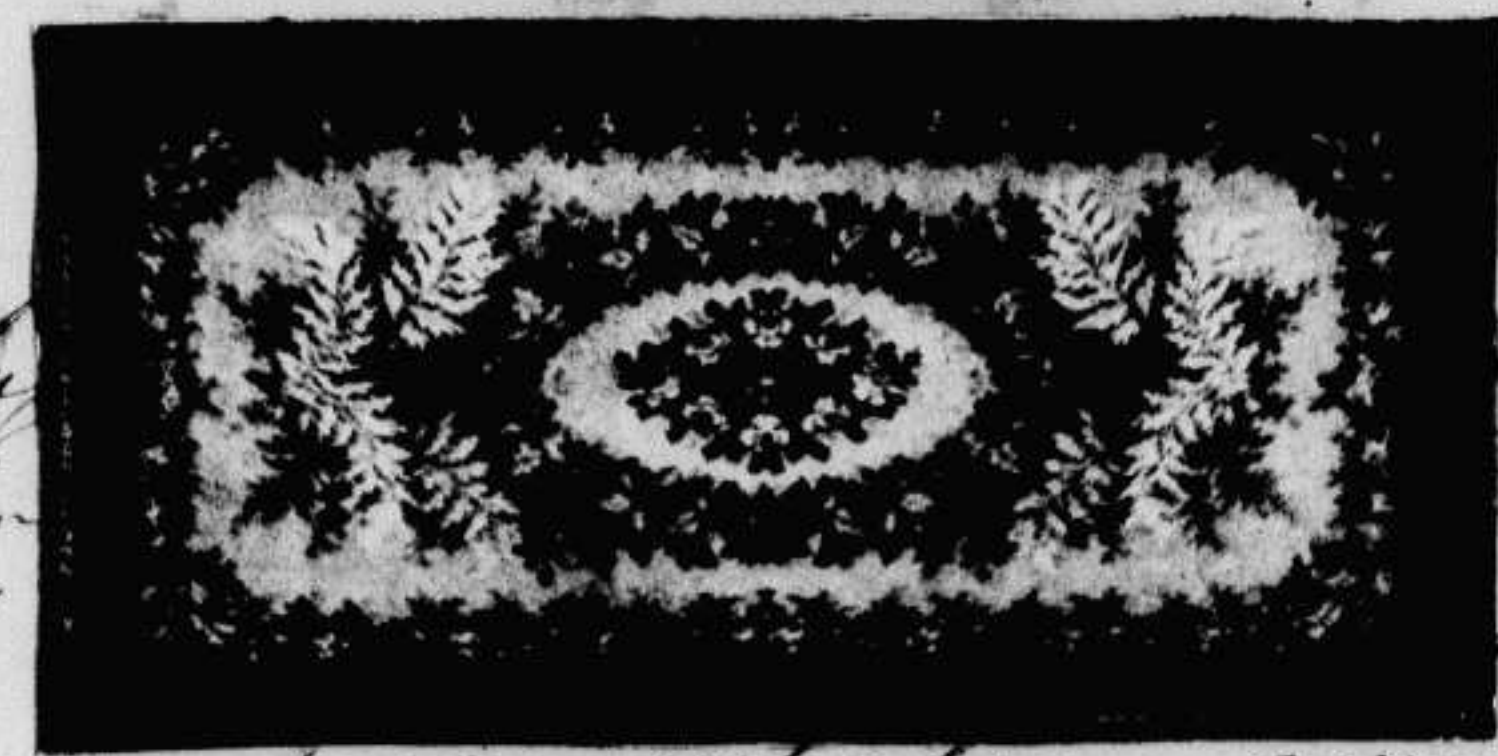
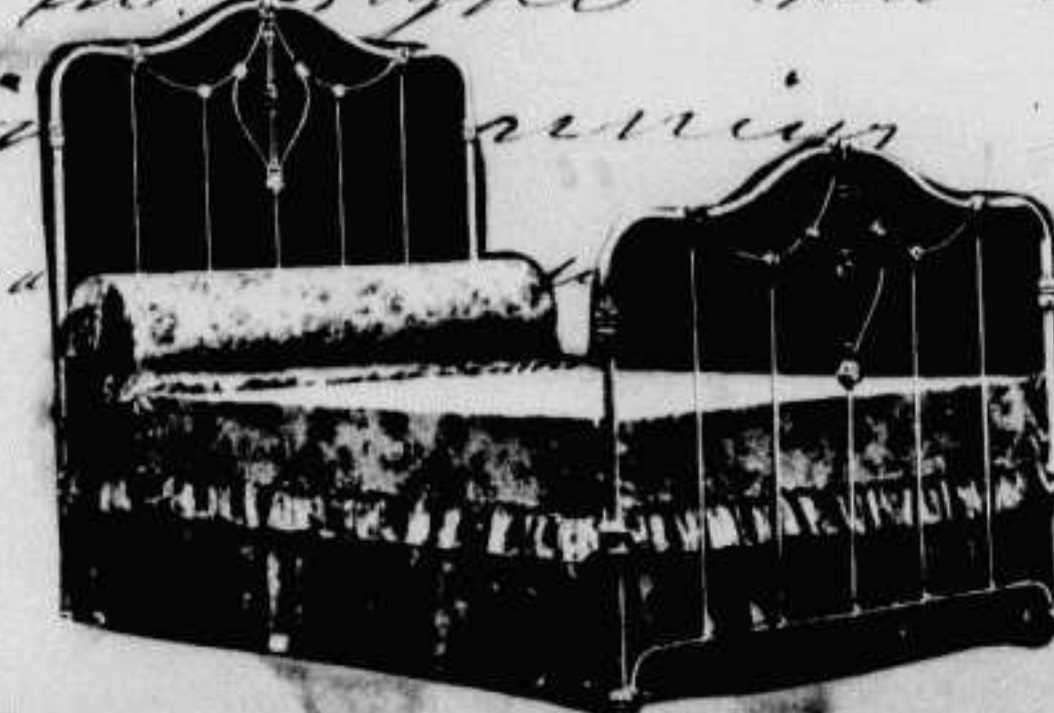
Monday the 3
