Friday the 14

This day commences with strong gale and a thick fog from the Northward ship laying two no sail out the riggers and ship froze up latter part a gale from the Westward and clear weather from the ship close reefed to sails set one sail in sight ship looking round so ends the day

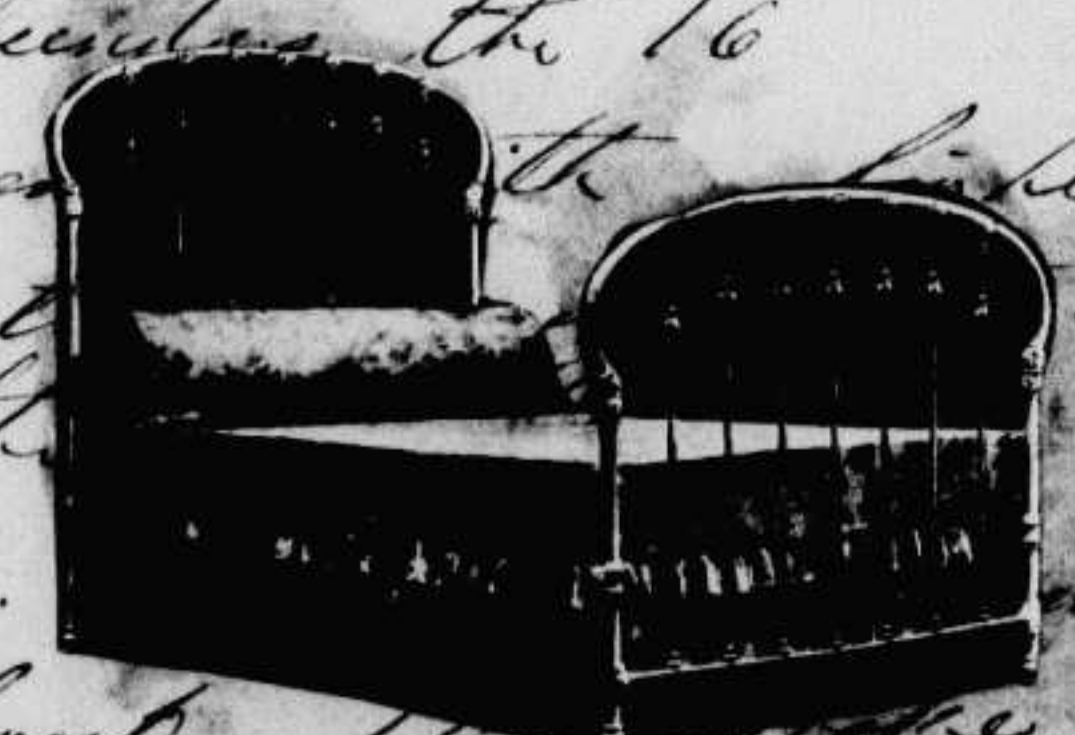
Saturday the 15
