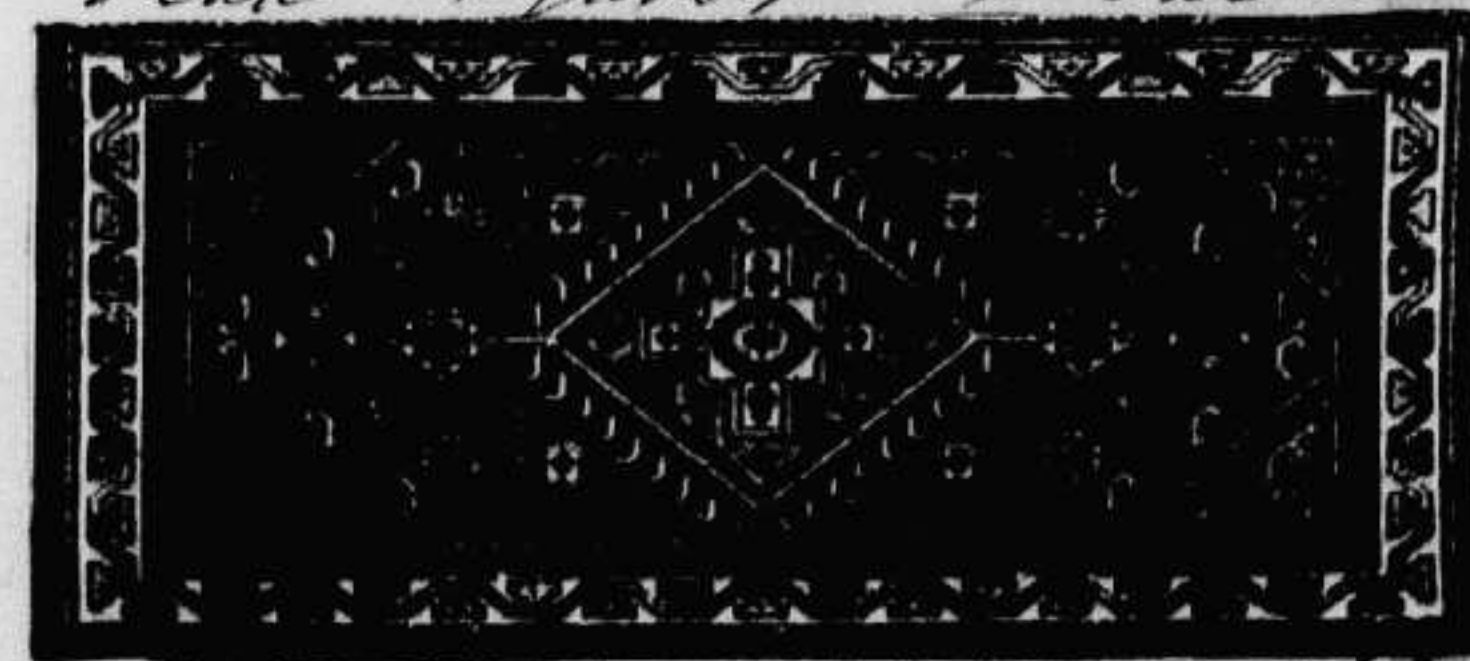
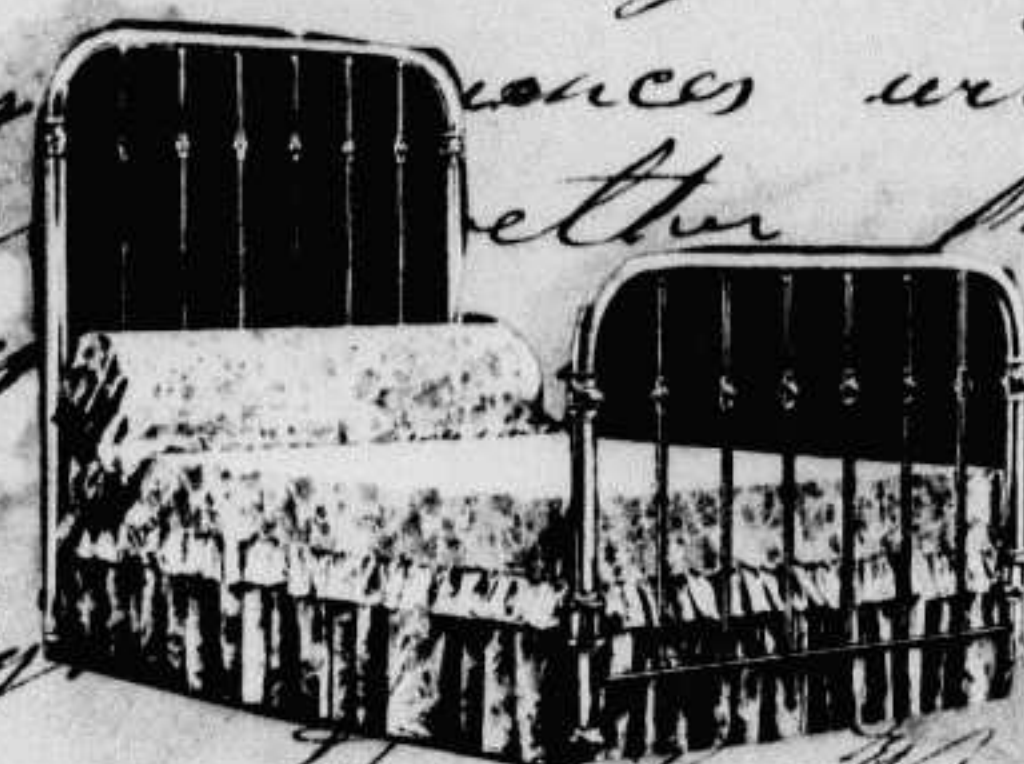
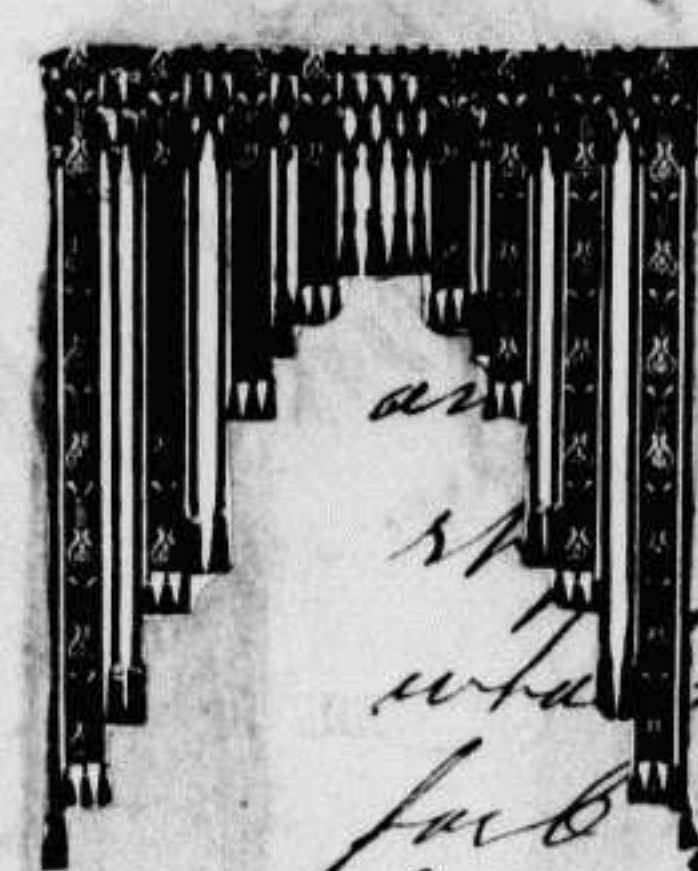
Friday the 21
