Wednesday the 23

This day commences with strong breeze and good weather from the S & W ship heading W by N all sail set employed in driving home latter part from breeze and good weather from the N ship heading W all sail set bound to Jarvis Island from the ship back so ends the day

Thursday the 24

This day commences with fresh breeze and a thick fog from the N ship steering off all sail set bound for Jarvis Island latter part strong breeze and thick weather from the N & E ship heading N W all sail set gunning with the ship china so ends the day

Friday the 25

This day commences with light breeze and thick weather from the S & E ship heading E S E all sail set gunning with the ship china of N Bedford captain Thompson latter part fresh breeze and thick weather from the Northward ship heading N with tack under short sail so ends the day

Saturday the 26

This day commences with light breeze and thick weather from the Northward ship steering S all sail set bound to the Chaceon gulf latter part light breeze and good weather from the Northward ship steering S all sail set bound to main voyage gunning with the ship. Fine and rainier so ends the day

Sunday the 27

This day commences with light breeze and good weather from the Northward ship steering S all sail set the land in sight 2 ships in sight broke out 3 barrels of sweat latter part light breeze and good weather from the E ship steering S S W all sail set the land in sight 2 ships in sight so ends the day

Monday the 28

This day commences with light breeze and good weather from the East ship steering S S W all sail set 2 ships in sight the land in sight latter part light breeze ship up in the gulf 2 ships in sight boats off cruising for whales so ends the day
