Saturday the 28

this day commences with light breeze and good weather ship all sail set working up towards ice and looking for whales latter part light breeze and good weather come to anchor of ice part a man ashore at the hospital with a sore leg
so ends the day

Sunday the 29

this day light breeze and good weather got underway made sail and stood out to sea heading to the Southward and Westward latter part light breeze ship all sail set heading for from the land lowered the boats for whales but got nothing
so ends the day

Monday the 30

this day commences with light breeze ship all sail set heading on either tack cruising for whales the land in sight 2 sails in sight latter part strong breeze from the N.E. ship double reef topsails and courses heading on either tack the land in sight
so ends the

Tuesday the 31

this day commences with strong breeze and rigged with from the N.E. ship double reef topsails and courses heading on either tack broke out cask of bread the land in sight latter part strong breeze and strong weather from the N.E. ship double reef topsails set and courses hanging off and on the land
so ends the day

September

September Wednesday the 1

this day commences with strong breeze and good weather from the N.E. ship broke out water ship standing off and on the land under short sail latter part light breeze and good weather from the N.E. ship all sail set steering N.N.E. the land in sight being low so ends the day
