this day commences with strong breeze and good weather from the N W ship steering E by S all sail set saw nothing to day latter part strong breeze and squally weather from the N E ship heading E under close reef main topsail heading E S E so ends the day

Tuesday the 19

this day commences with a strong gale and rain from the N E ship heading E by S under close reef main topsail latter part strong breeze and squally weather from the N ship heading E by S double reef topsails and courses set broke out some meat so ends the day
