ship steering E S E double reef top
sails and fore sail bent fore topsails
latter part light breeze from the
S W ship steering E S E all
sail set broke out for water
so ends the day

Thursday the 28
this day commences with light
breeze and good weather from the
W the ship steering E S E all
sail set broke out for butter and
tongues and pickles latter part light breeze
and squally weather all hands was called
to witness a burial of one of our men
who had been sick a long time
so ends the day

Friday the 29
this day commences with light and cool
of typhoon from the N W the
ship two under fore pole lost the
foretopmast staysail middle part broken
ing hard latter part more moderate breeze
of steering E S E double reef topsails
and foresail so ends the day
Feb 41: 03
Long 165: 43 W

Saturday the 30
this day commences with strong gale
and squally weather from the S W the
ship steering E S E double reef top
sails and fore sail latter part light
breeze and good weather from the S
ship heading E by S all sail set
so ends the day
