and setting up rigging latter part
light breeze and good weather from
the N E ship steering N W by N
all sail set employed in
mending sails so ends the day

Saturday the 5th
this day commences with light
breeze and pleasant weather ship
all sail set employed in mending
sails broke out a cask of beer
and pent the mainsail latter part
strong breeze and good weather
from the N E ship heading N W
all sail set so ends the day
