this day commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from the N.W. ship heading N.E. by N. all sail set gathering with Gideon Headland trying to get through the straits into Japan better part strong breeze and rugged weather from the N.E. ship heading to the N.W. by W. all sail set the land in right bow so much the day

Bound to the Japan Sea 1859

Saturday the 18

this day commences with a strong gale from the N.E. ship lying to under close reefed main top sail the gale island in sight one ship in sight better part strong breeze and rugged weather from the N.E. ship close reefed top sail and reef fore sail heading on with tack working to the windward the land in right bow sail in right so much the day

Sunday the 19

this day commences with strong breeze and rugged weather from the N.E. ship heading on with tack beating to the windward double reefed top sail and courses the land in right one sail in right better part light breeze and good weather from the N.W. ship all sail heading N.W. by W. the land in right so much the day

Monday the 20

this day commences with light breeze and good weather from the N.W. ship all sail set at the mouth of the straits of Corea broke out for flour better part light breeze and good weather from the N.W. ship heading E. by N. all sail set passed through straits into the Japan Sea two sails in right so much the day
